THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Queen Margaret's Inch, chapel and crannog comprises a crannog of prehistoric date, which later formed the site of a medieval chapel, surviving as a promontory in a partially drained loch. The area to be scheduled comprises the remains described and an area around them within which related material may be expected to survive. It is irregular in shape, measuring 175m between its E-most and W-most points, and 180m between its N-most and S-most points. Above-ground elements of modern buildings, fixtures and jetties which occupy parts of the site are excluded from the scheduling. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Forfar and the County of Angus as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms



, is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

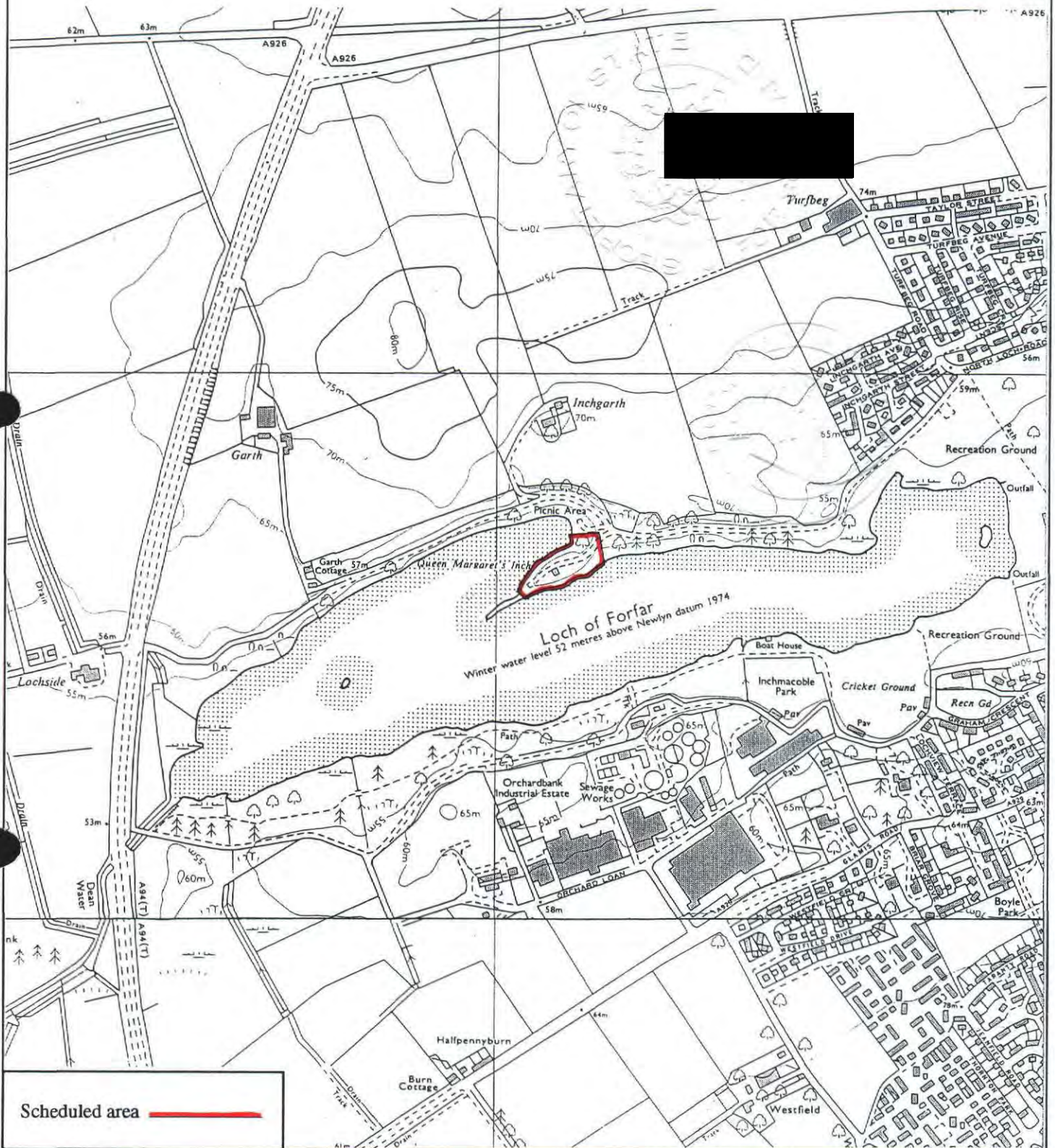

Scheduled area

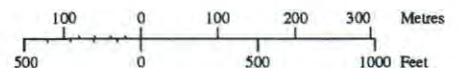
**Queen Margaret's Inch, chapel and crannog**
