ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Aberdeenshire Canal, remains of, NW of Brae of Kintore comprises the remains of a stretch of the Aberdeenshire Canal Navigation, or Aberdeen-Inverurie Canal. The area to be scheduled includes the remains of the canal and the milestone and extends some 440m NW-SE and a maximum of 25m N-S, specifically excluding a 40m stretch at roughly the mid point which has been obliterated by the garden and driveway of Carler House. Its boundary is defined on the north by the edge of the road, on the south by the northern edge of the track between Brae of Kintore farm and Carler House and by the field boundary W of Carler House as far as Rosebank House, and on the W by the fence of Rosebank House. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kintore and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

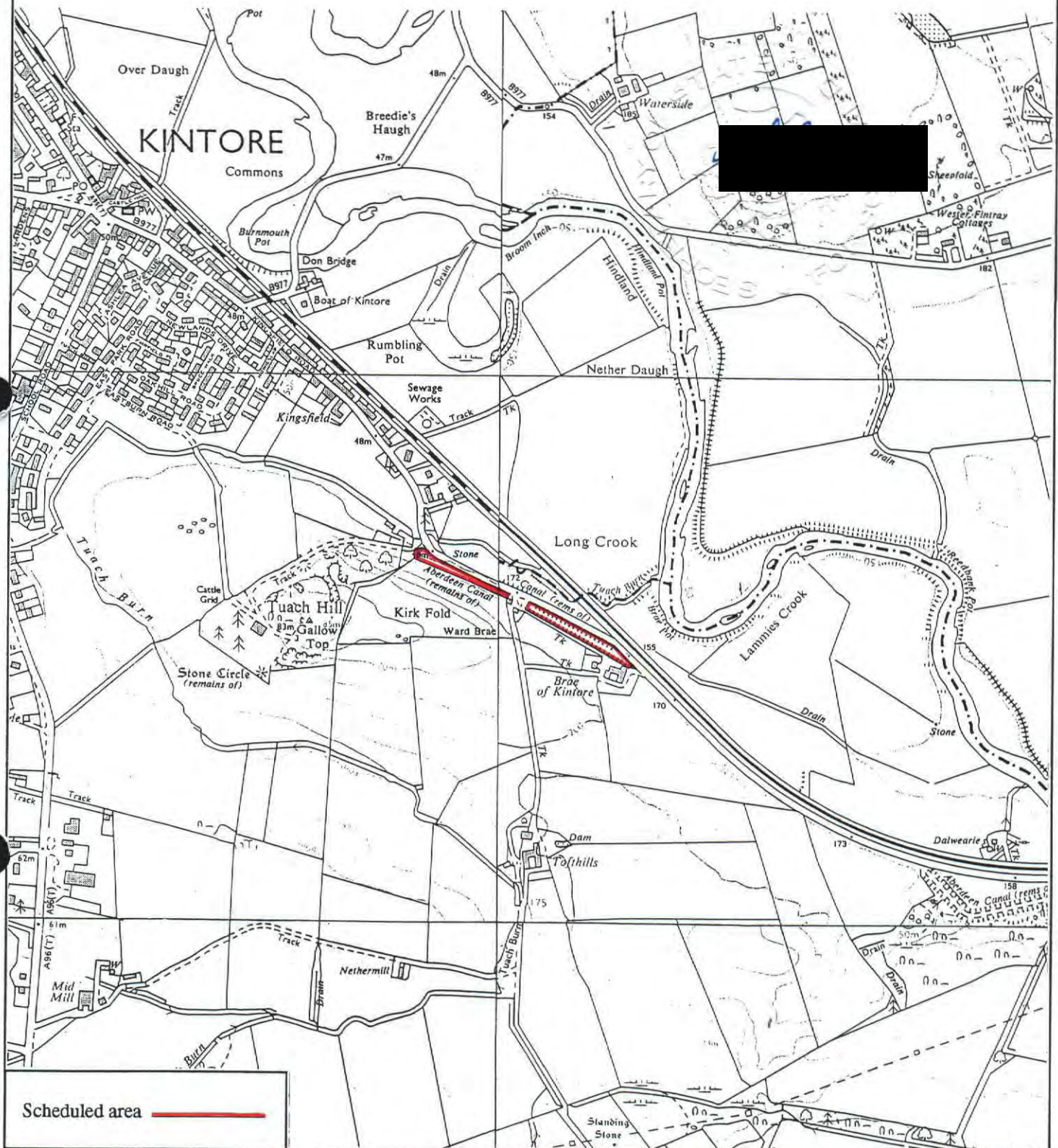

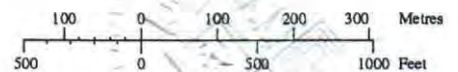
Aberdeenshire Canal, remains of,
