ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Aberdeenshire Canal, remains of, S of Dalwearie comprises the remains of a stretch of the Aberdeenshire Canal Navigation, or Aberdeen-Inverurie Canal. The area to be scheduled comprises a strip 30m wide, to include the canal bed and enclosing embankments, extending from a point in the west 17m south of the fence bordering the road and continuing for a distance of some 120m SE, followed by a further 380m ENE as far as the fence bordering the south side of the railway, excluding the short section between the fences where the modern road crosses the line of the canal but including the stone-built structures and enclosure immediately south of the road at this point. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kintore and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

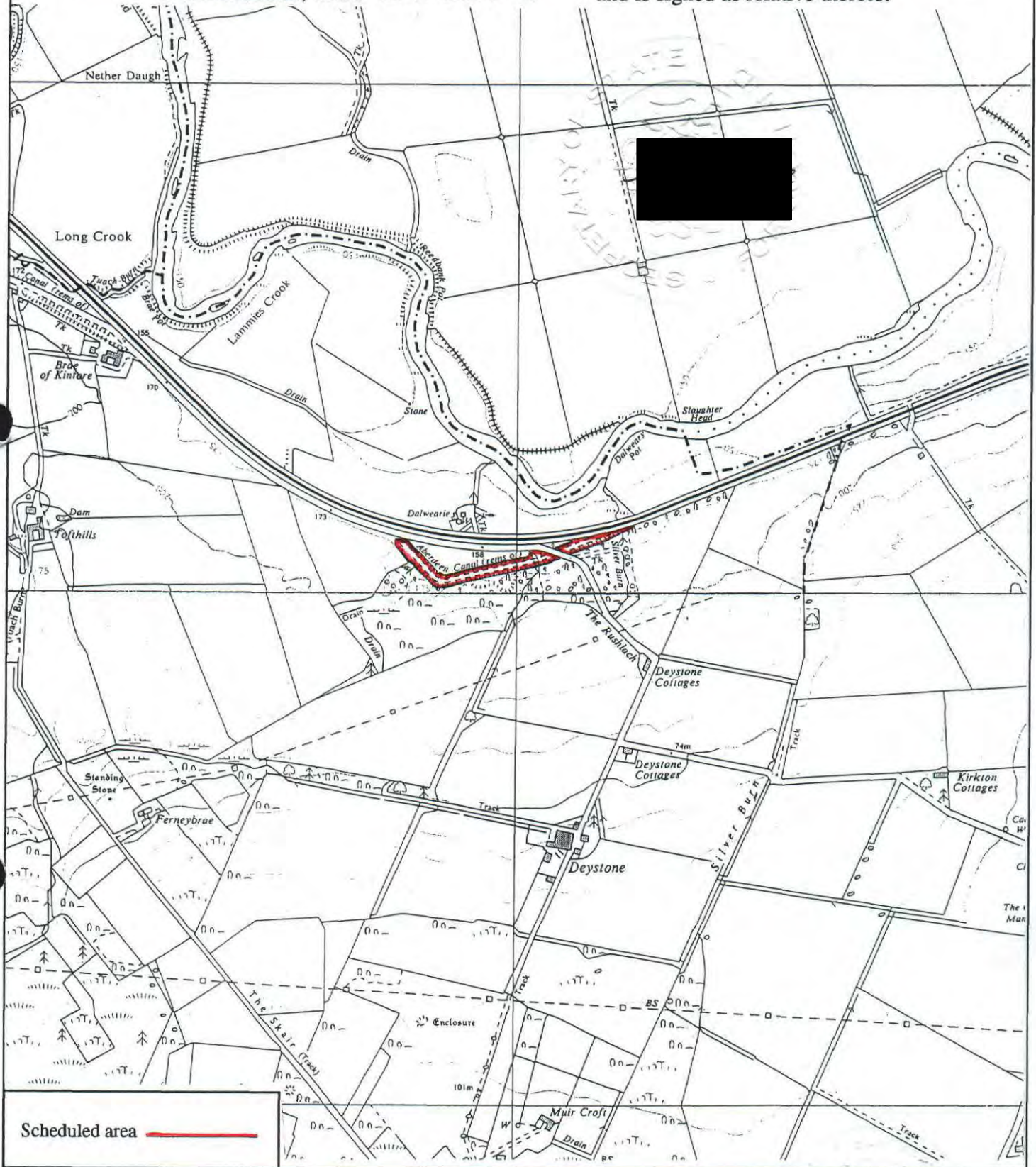

Scheduled area

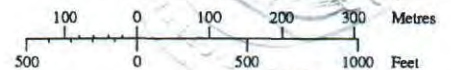
Aberdeenshire Canal, remains of,
