ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Loomi Shun, homestead S of Sevdale, Unst comprises the remains of a prehistoric homestead. The area to be scheduled is a circle of diameter 35m, to include the homestead and an area around it in which evidence relating to its construction and use may survive. The area reaches, but does not cross, the modern fence to the NNE. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Unst and the County of Shetland as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

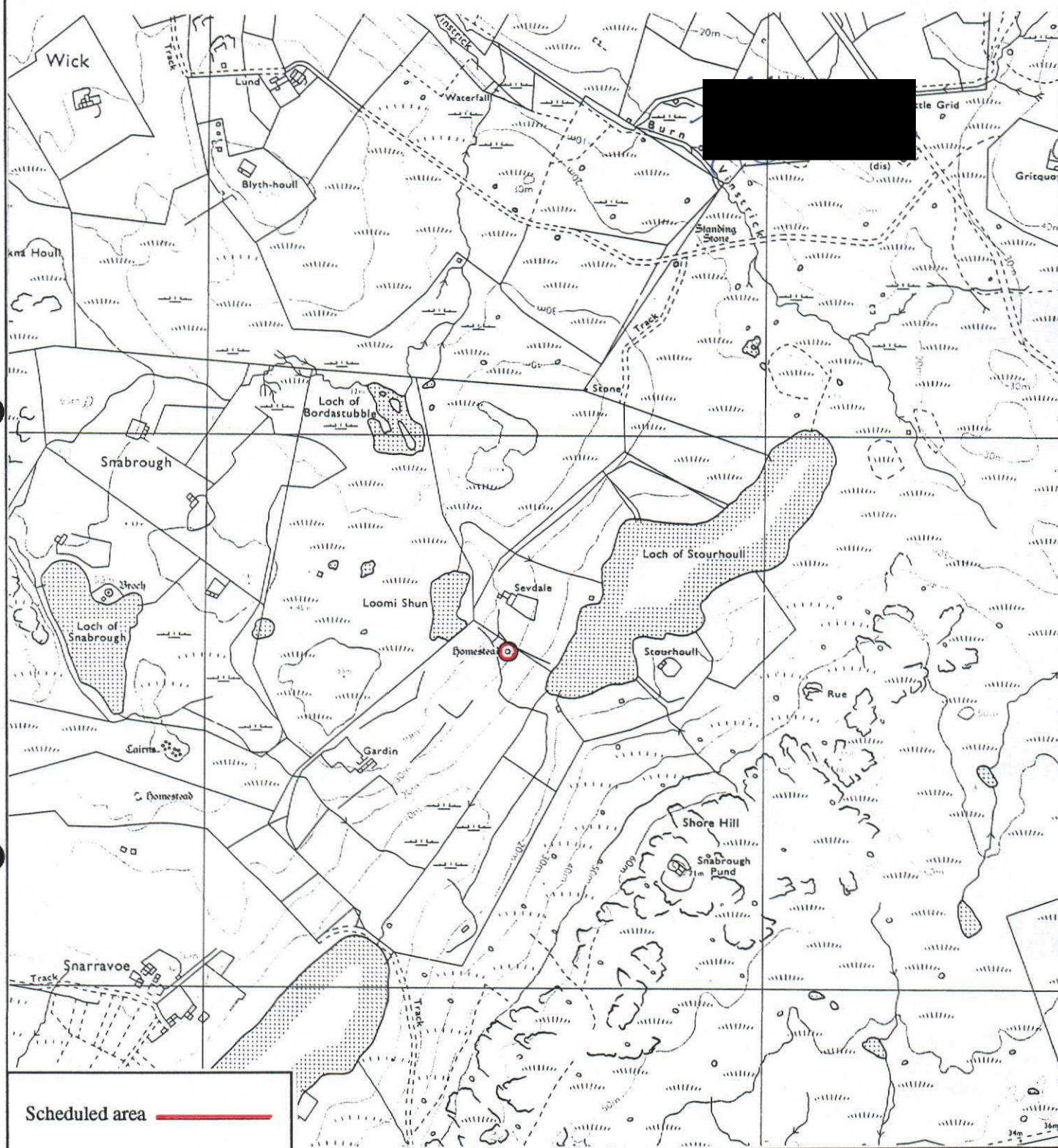

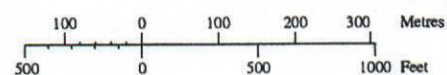
