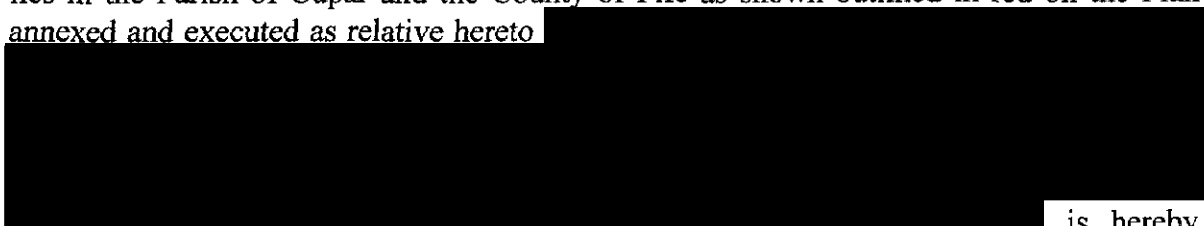
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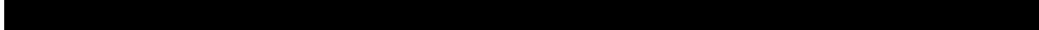

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Cupar, St Christopher's Church (remains of) comprises the remains of Cupar's medieval church, its graveyard and traces of a surrounding oval enclosure, which lay outwith and to the north of the burgh. The area to be scheduled is an irregular quadrilateral in shape measuring 70m NW-SE by 100m NE-SW, to include the remains of the Church and graveyard and traces of the oval enclosure, plus an area around these features within which associated remains are likely to survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Cupar and the County of Fife as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto 

 is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

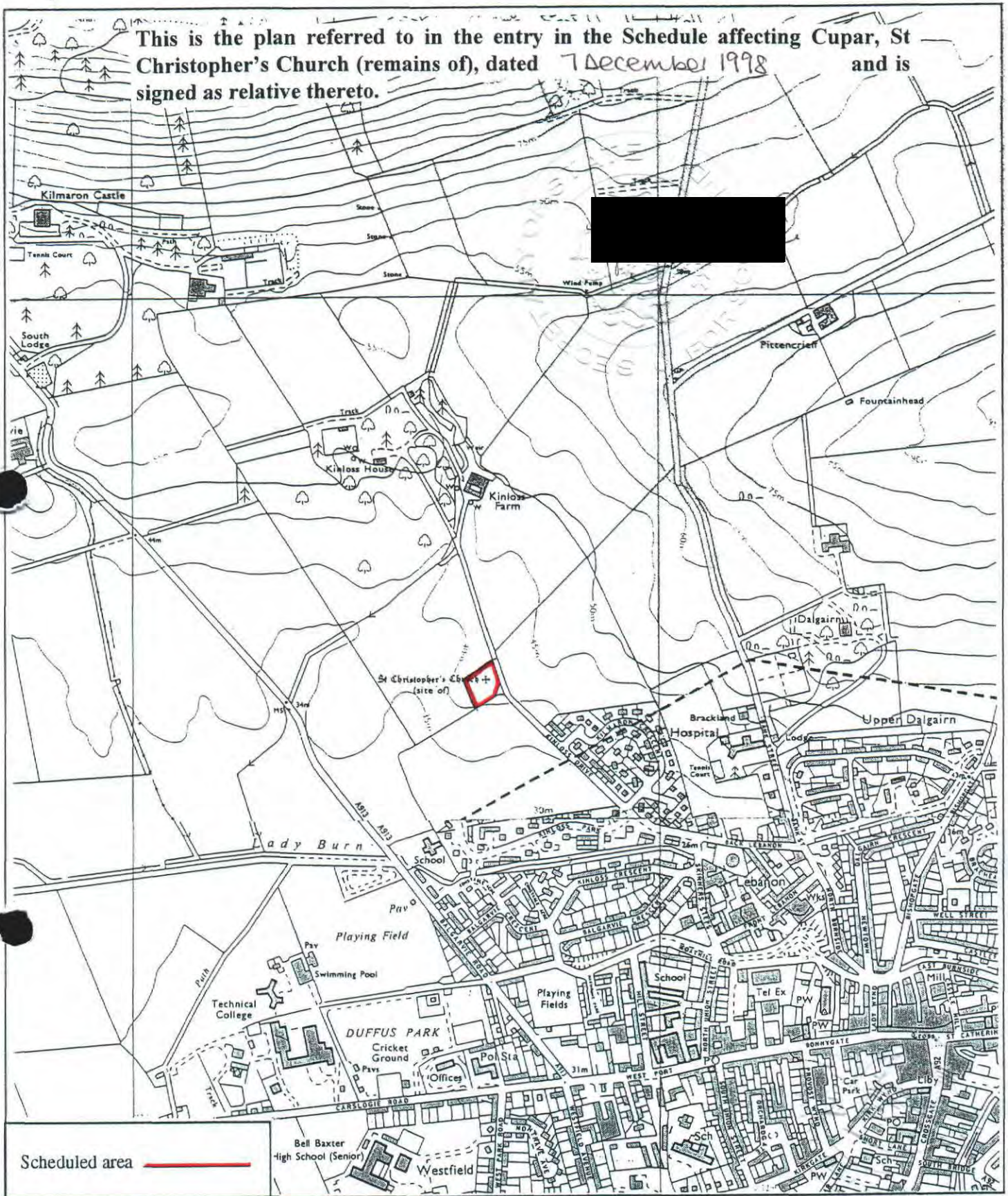

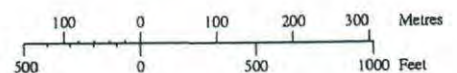
Cupar, St Christopher's Church
