

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Whitekirk, remains of Pilgrims' Houses around Tithe Barn comprises the remains of early 15th-century pilgrims' houses. The area to be scheduled is approximately oval in shape and follows the contour at the base of the ridge of ground on which the tithe barn sits. It has maximum dimensions of 38m N-S and 95m ENE-WNW and includes the excavated remains and the remainder of the ridge, on which associated remains are expected to survive. The tithe barn itself and an area around it which extends 3m beyond its walls is excluded. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Whitekirk and Tynninghame and the County of East Lothian as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto 

 is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

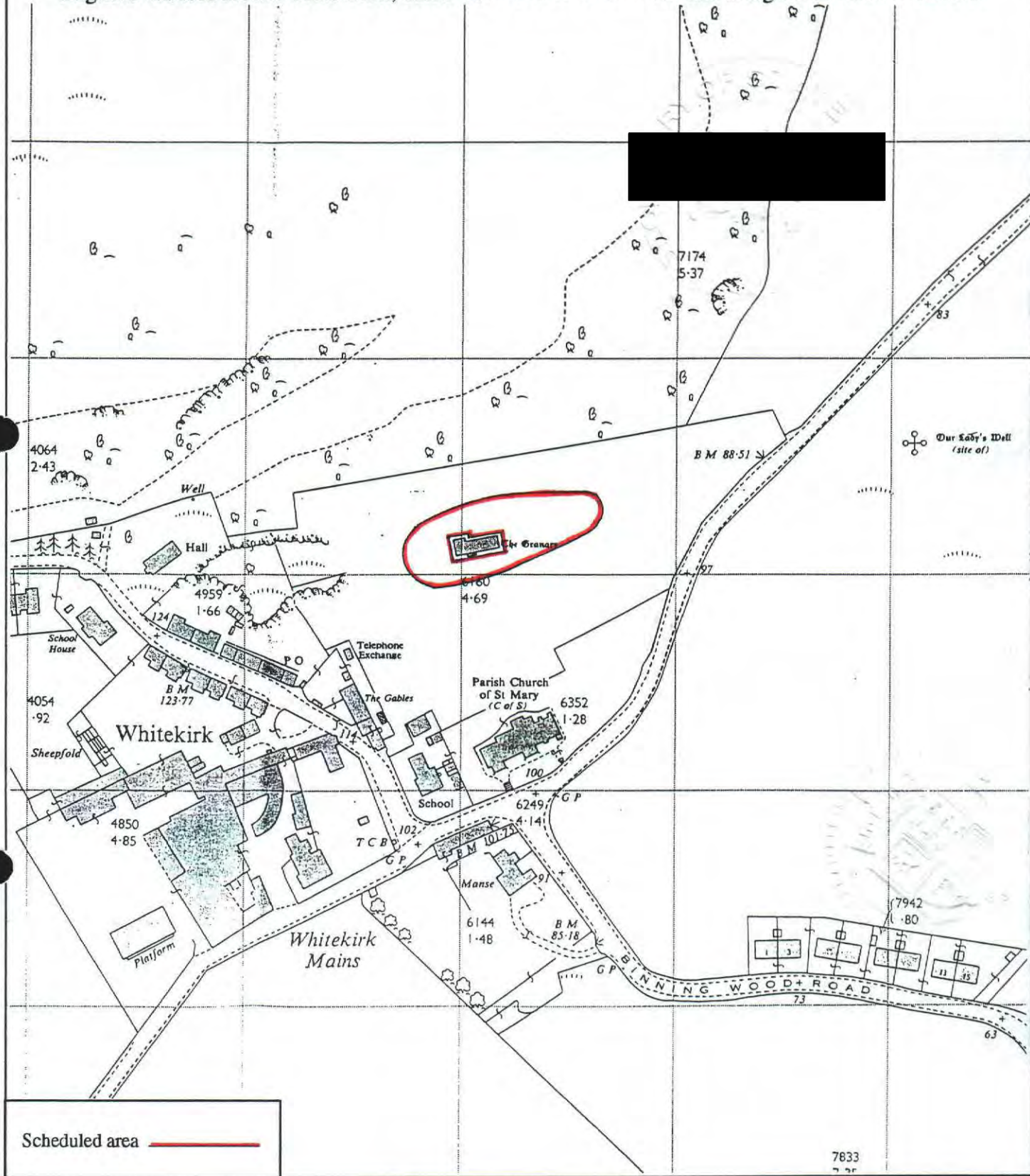
