ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Girthon Old Parish Church comprises a roofless, predominantly early 17th century church with rubble walls and dressed quoins. The area to be scheduled is a rectangle 35m E-W by 25m to include the church, its interior and an area of ground extending 5m out from its outer walls on all sides. All lairs with existing burial rights are excluded from scheduling. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Girthon and the County of Stewartry of Kirkcudbright as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

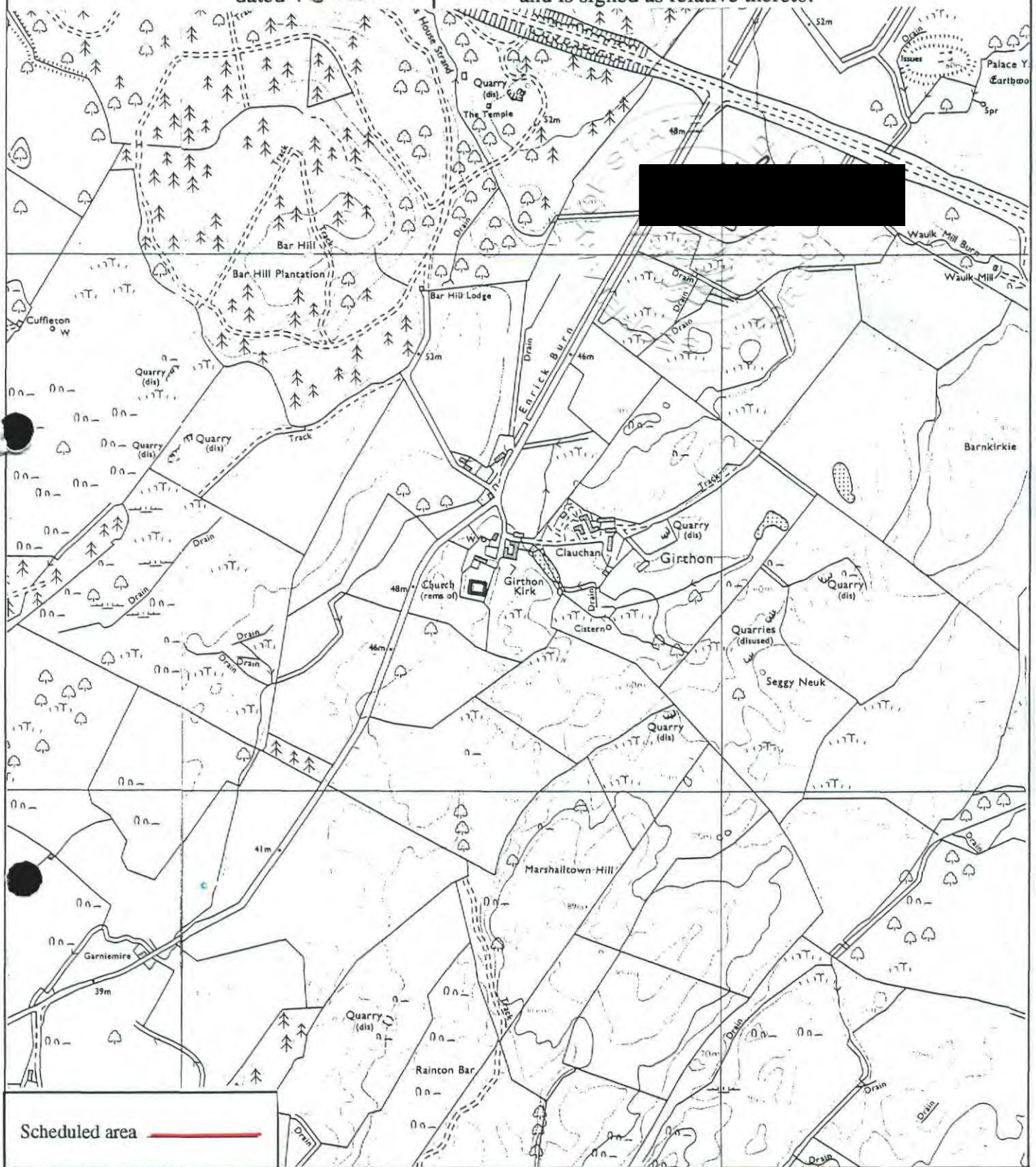

Scheduled area

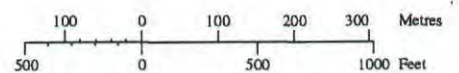
Girthon Old Parish Church
