ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Table Rings, cairn 500m WSW of Penshiel comprises a burial cairn of prehistoric date, visible as a prominent grass-and heather-covered mound with surrounding bank and ditch. The area to be scheduled comprises the remains described and an area around them within which related material may be expected to be found. It is circular with a diameter of 70m. The modern sunken grouse butt which lies in the NE part of the scheduled area is excluded from this scheduling. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Whittinghame and the County of East Lothian as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.
