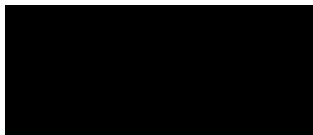

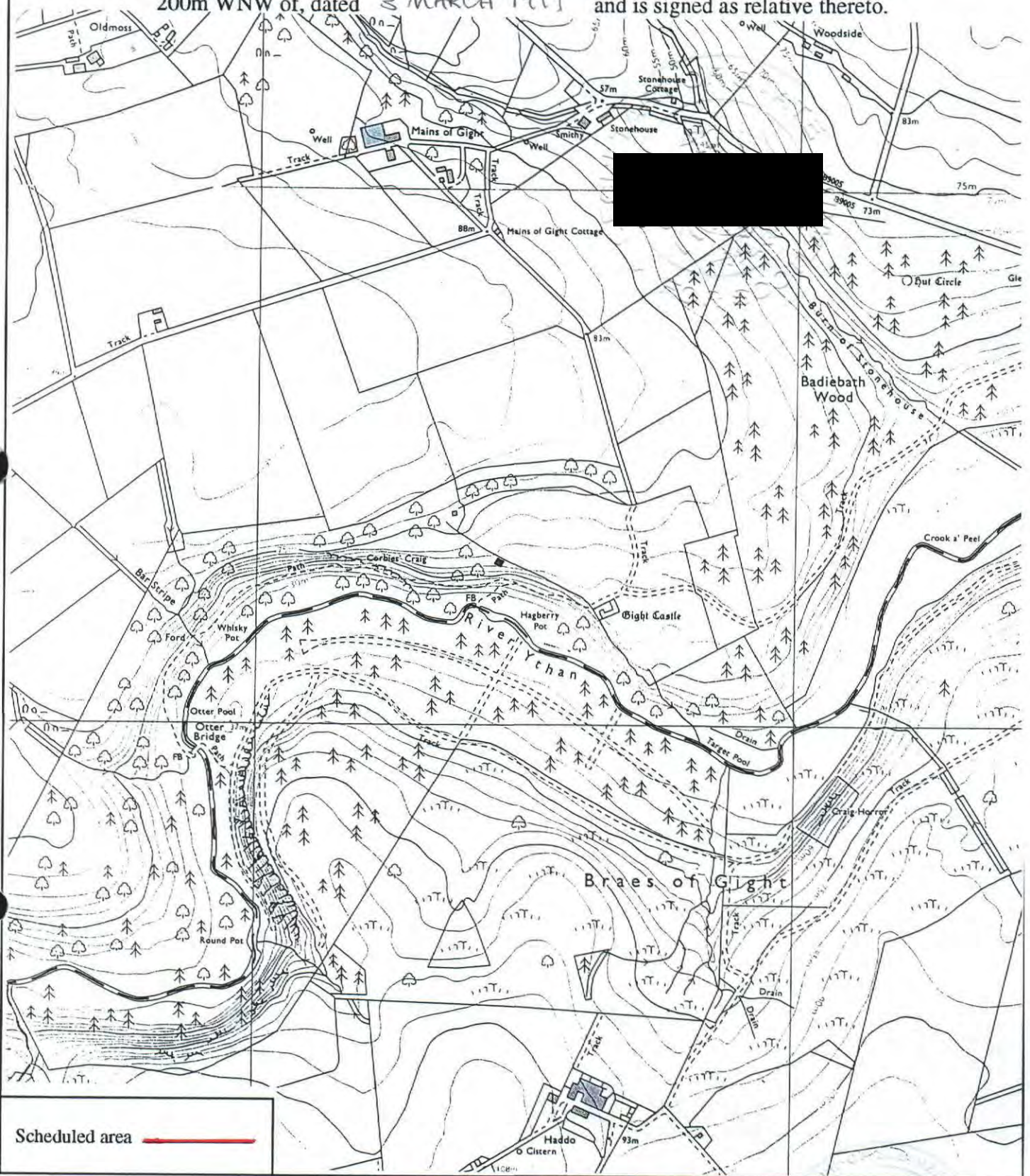

Scheduled area

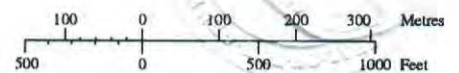
Gight Castle, dovecot 200m
