

The monument known as Ferny Howe, cairn 200m ESE of comprises the remains of a probable burial cairn located on sloping ground some way to the W of an unfinished hillfort. The area to be scheduled is 45m in diameter, to include the probable cairn and an area around it in which traces of activities associated with the construction and use of the cairn may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Logie-Coldstone and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

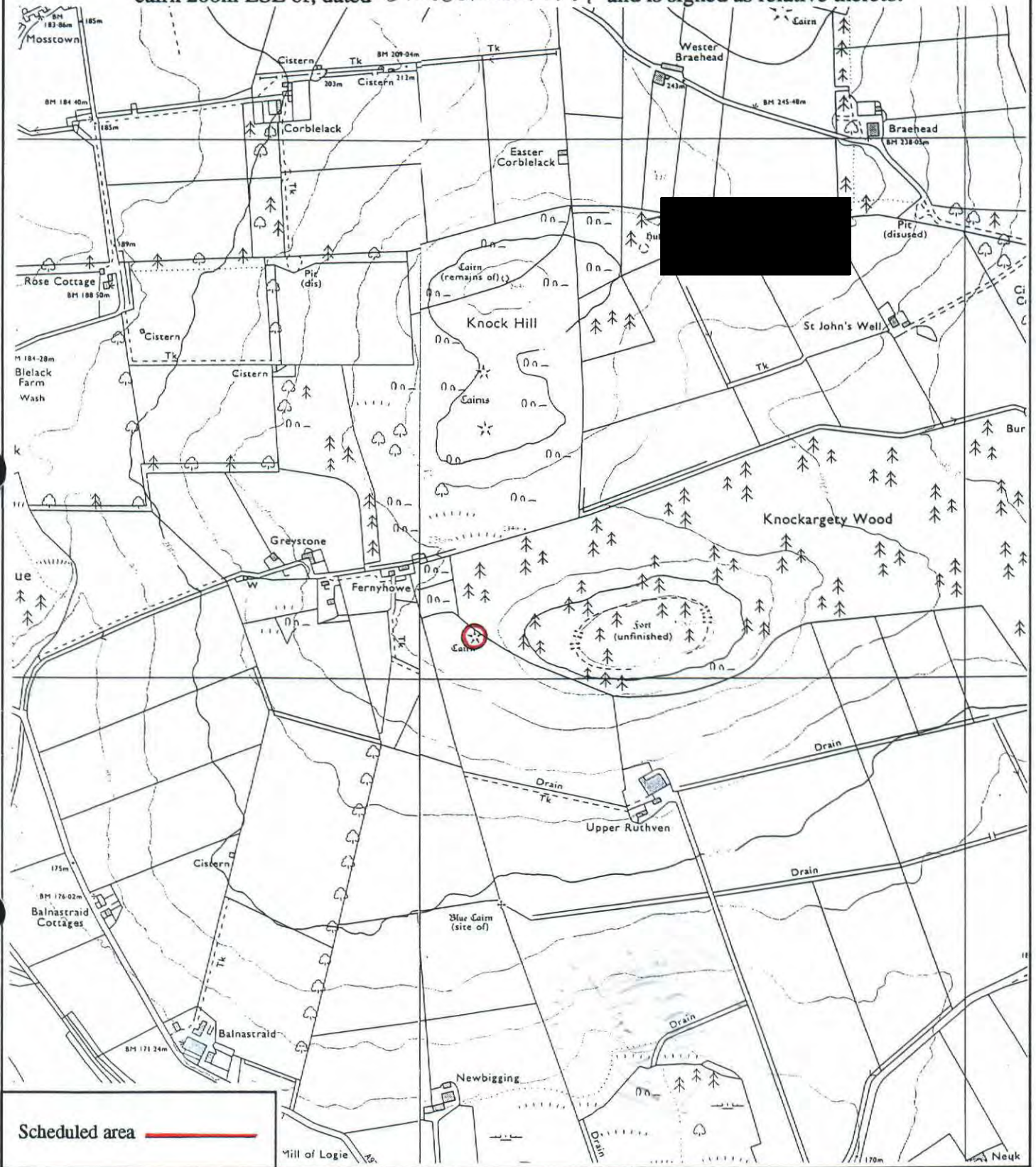

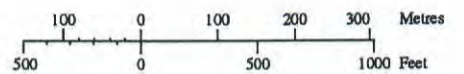
Ferny Howe, cairn 200m ESE of
