The monument known as Loch Doon Castle, original site and remains of, 570m NE of Craigmalloch comprises the original island site and partial remains of Loch Doon castle. The area to be scheduled is circular in shape, with a diameter of 100m to include the upstanding masonry and an area around it, within which associated remains are expected to survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Straiton and the County of Ayr as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

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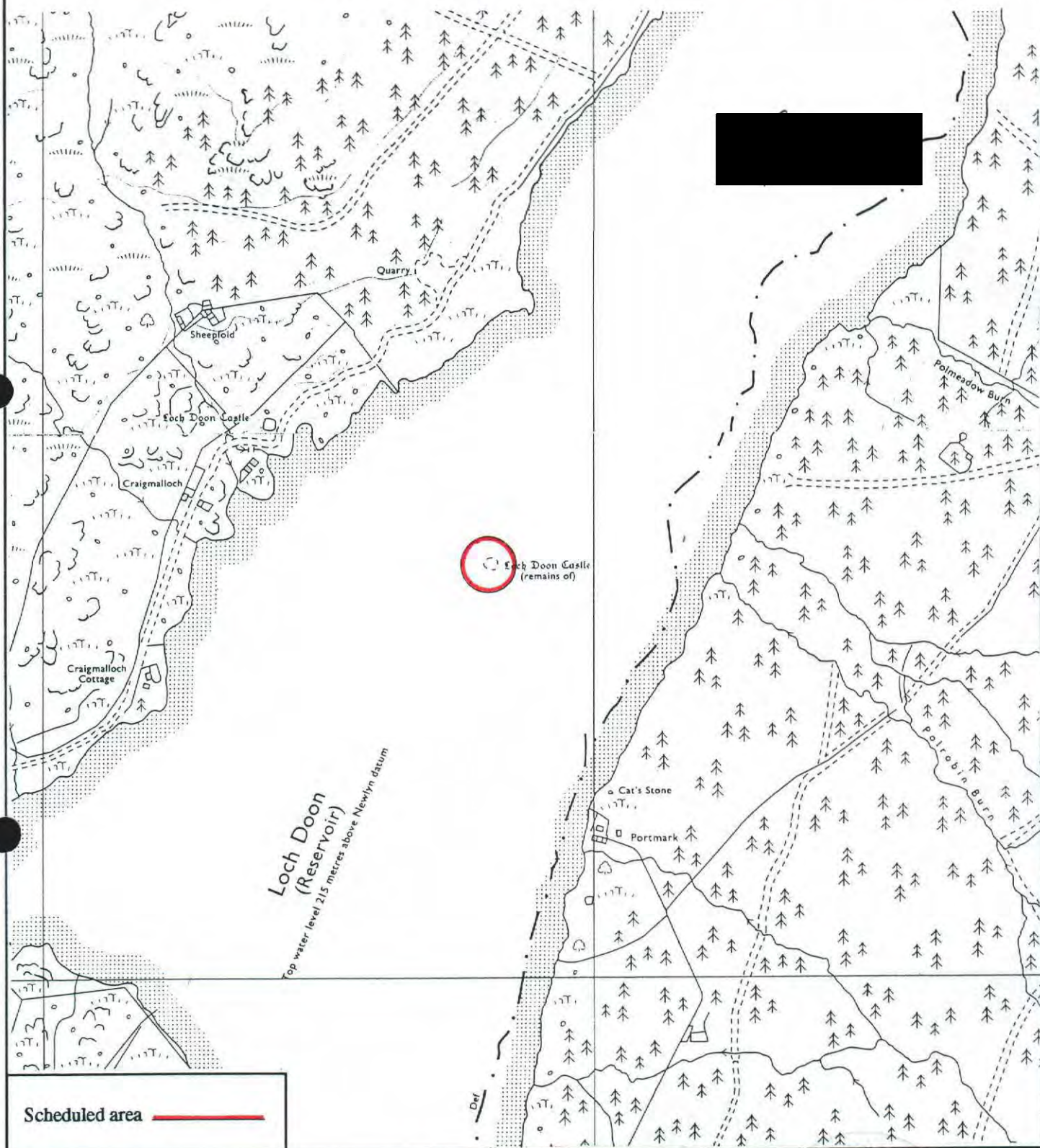

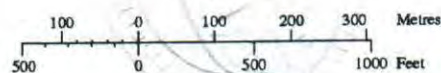
Loch Doon Castle, original site and remains of, 570m NE of Craigmalloch
