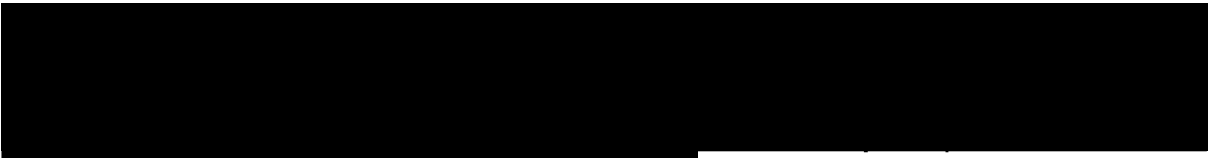

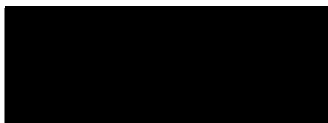
THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Bridge of Dye, pill boxes 60m and 35m W of comprises the remains of two pill boxes of the 1939-45 war. The area to be scheduled comprises the pill boxes themselves and a zone of c.2m around the outer surface of the walls, as well as surviving fragments of the granite wall linking them and an area c.2m from both faces of the wall. Road surfaces and the existing crash barriers are specifically excluded from the scheduling. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Strachan and the County of Kincardine as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

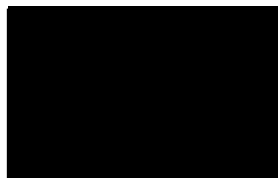

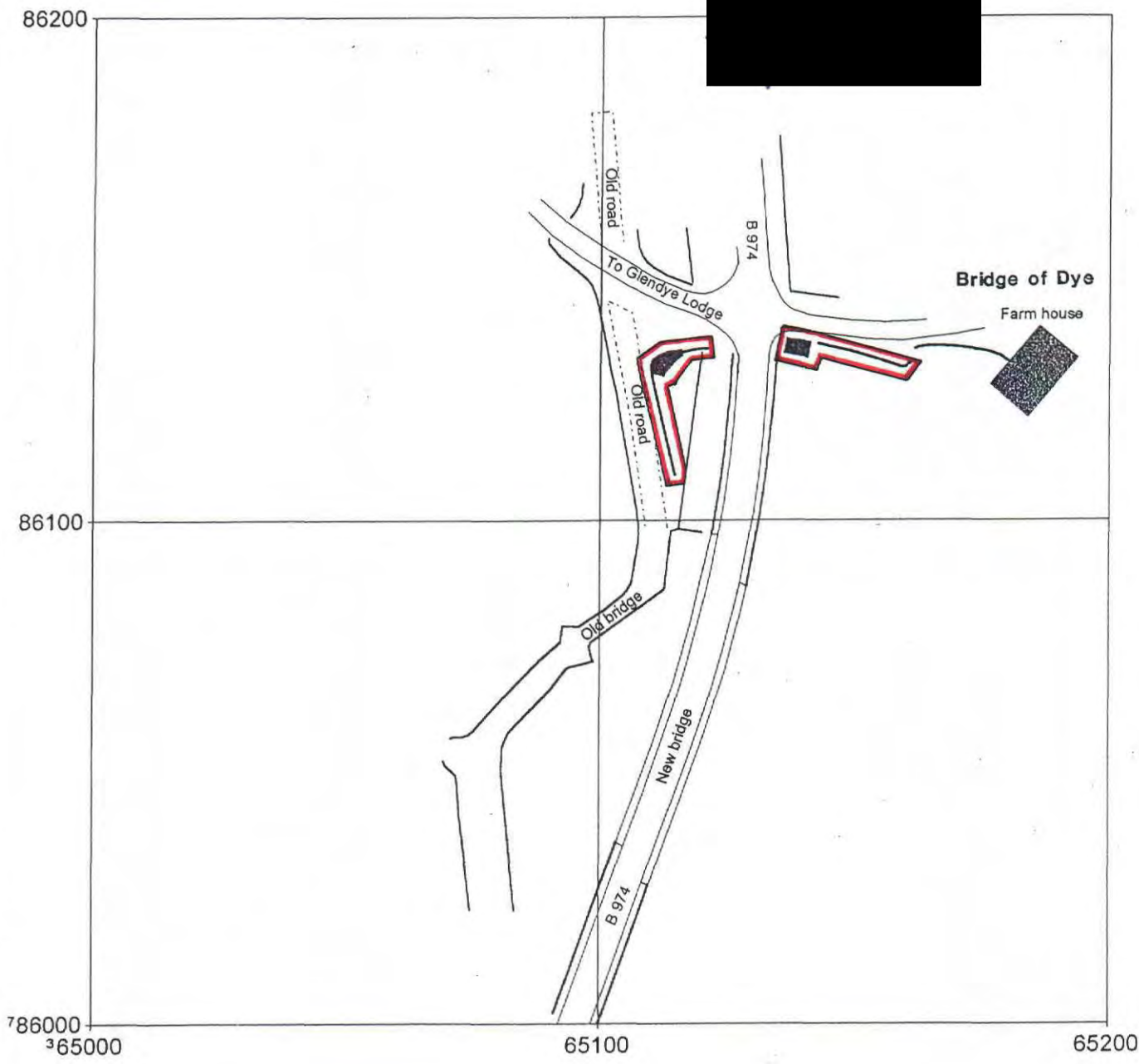


