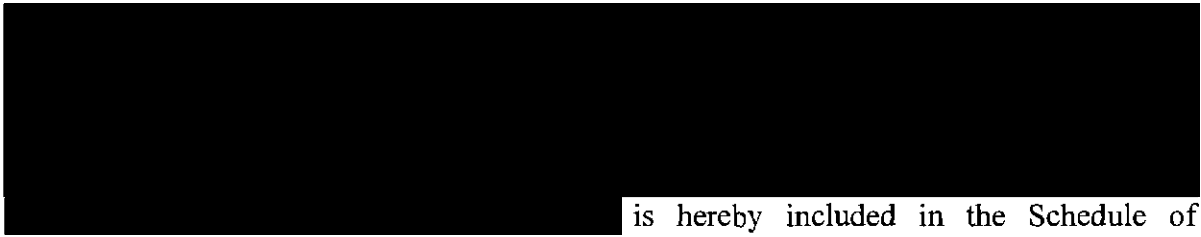

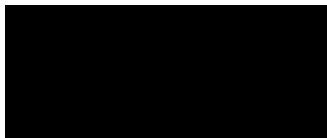

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Seacliff Tower comprises a tower of late 16th century date, visible as upstanding remains. The area to be scheduled comprises the remains described and an area around them in which related material may be expected to be found. It is irregular on plan, measuring a maximum extent of 40m from W to E by 25m transversely. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Whitekirk and Tynninghame and the County of East Lothian as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

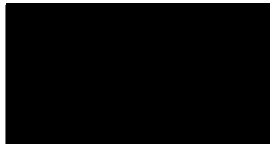

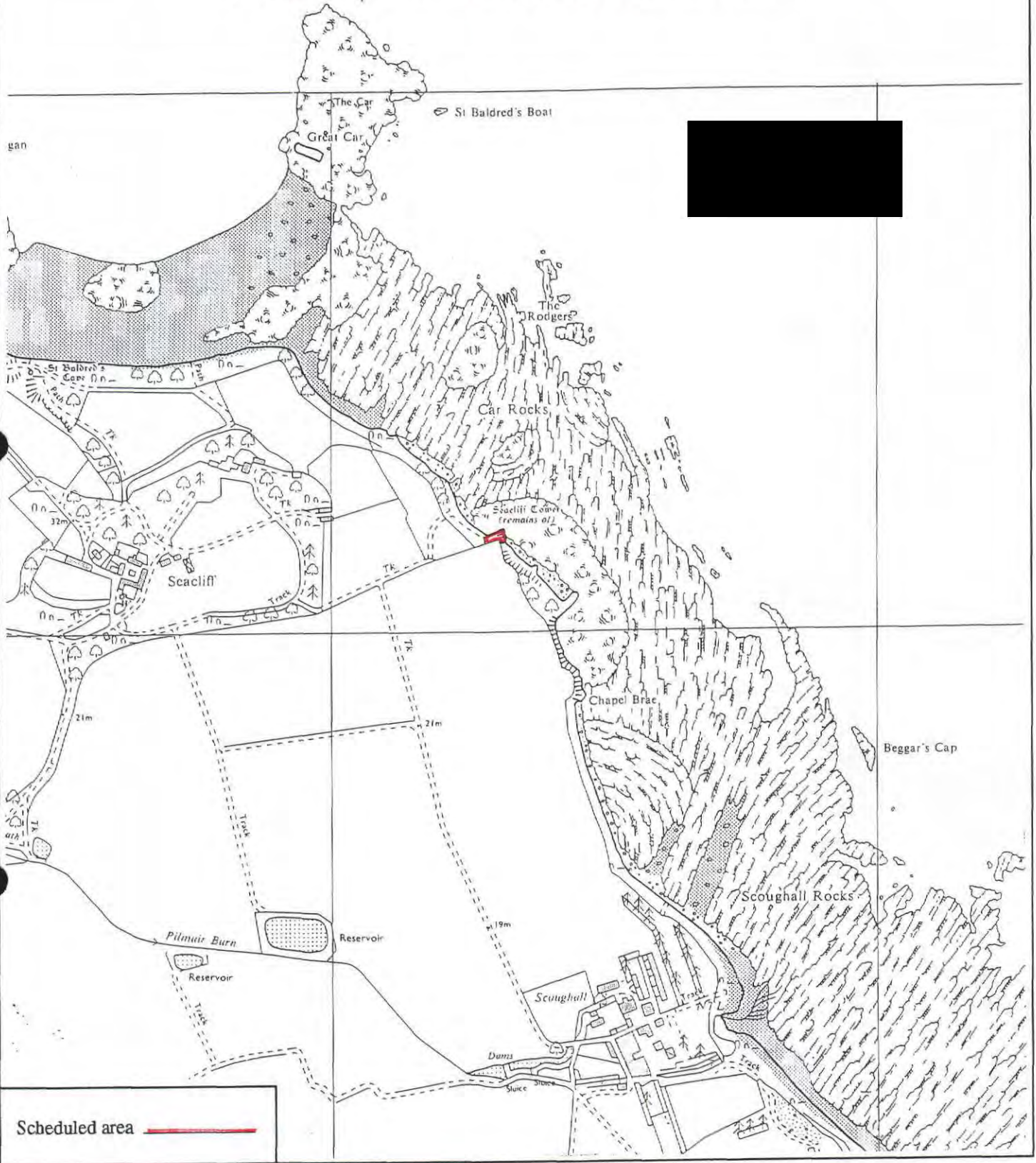

Scheduled area

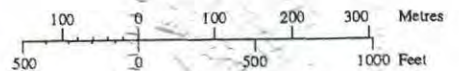
Seacliff Tower
