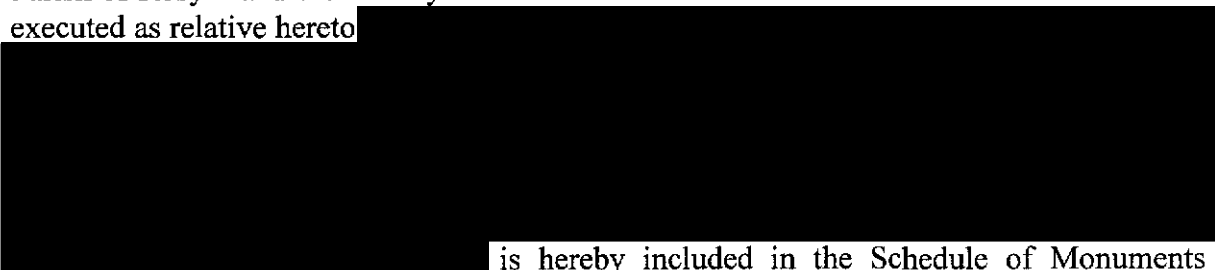

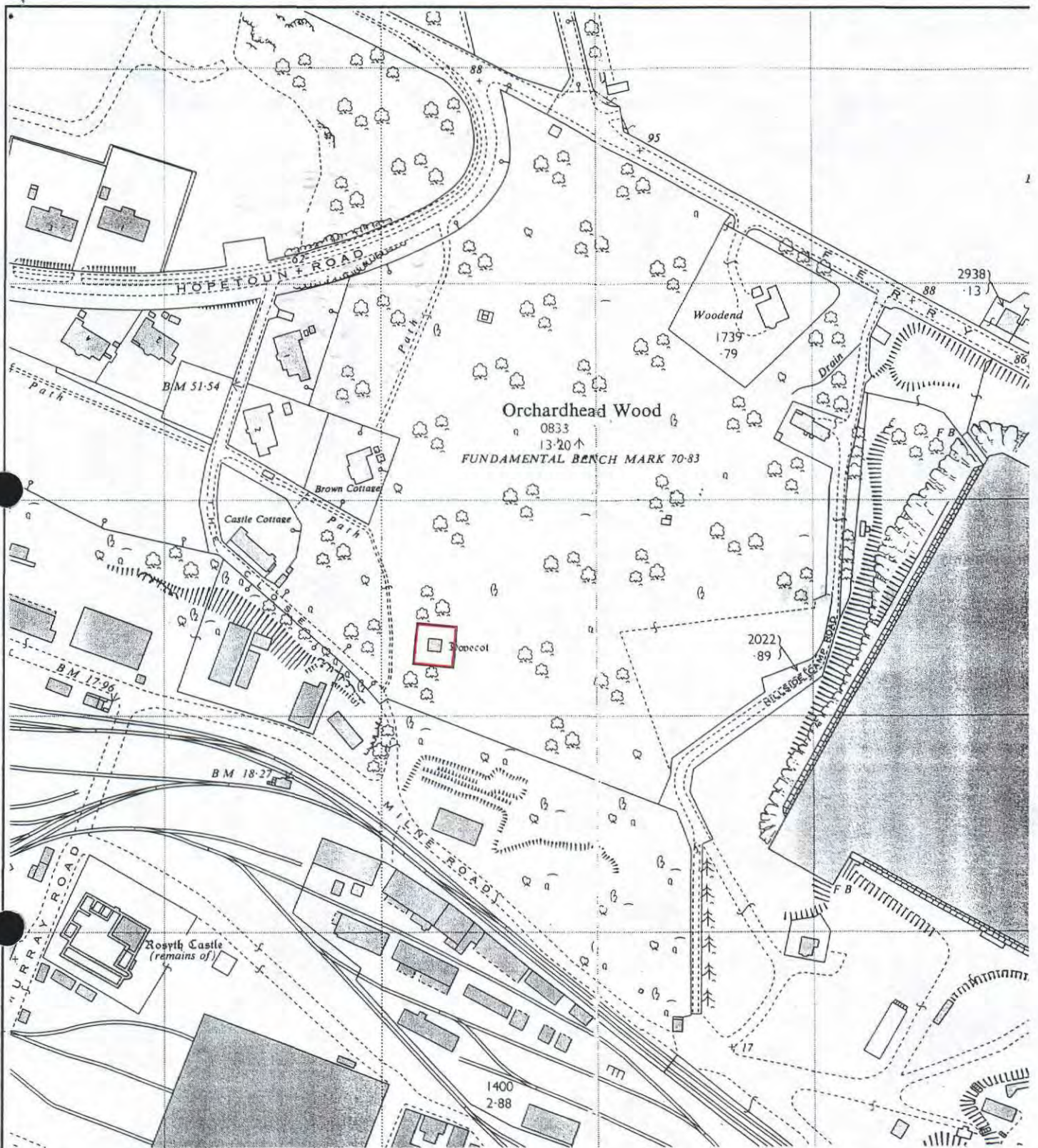

Scheduled area —

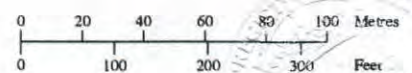
Rosyth Castle Dovecot
