ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Scapa Flow, wrecks of 3 battleships of German High Seas Fleet comprises the remains of three vessels of the German High Seas Fleet, scuttled in Scapa Flow on 21 June 1919, together with an area of seabed around each wreck in which associated debris is scattered. The 3 vessels comprise the battleships Konig, Kronprinz Wilhelm and Markgraf. All lie to the NE of the island of Cava. These remains are the only surviving examples of capital ships from the interned Fleet. The areas to be scheduled consist of 3 circular areas of seabed, each 500m in diameter. These areas include the hull of each vessel and the debris field associated with each and a small area around, in which further remains may survive below the surface sediment. The monument, which lies in the County of Orkney as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

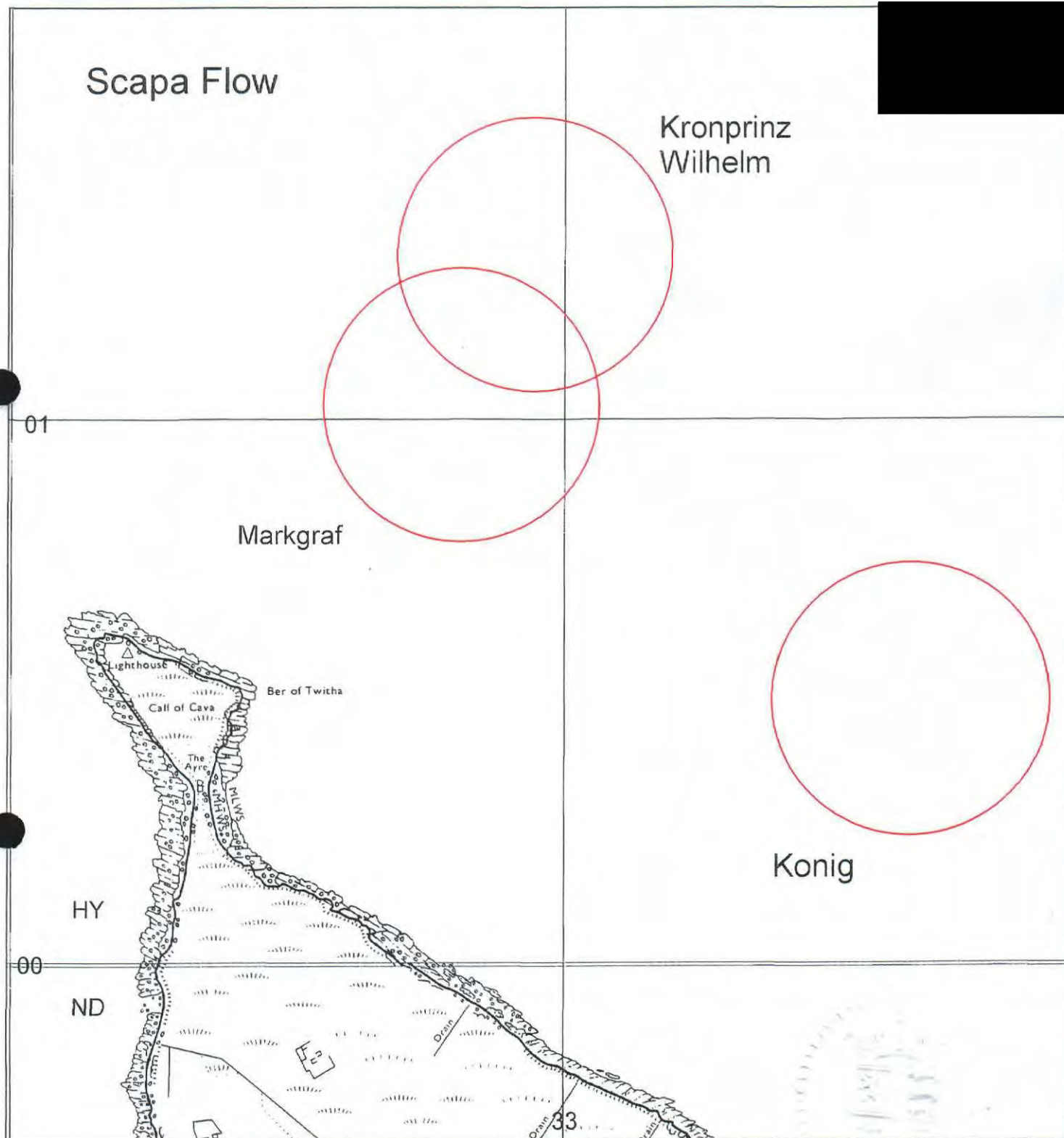
