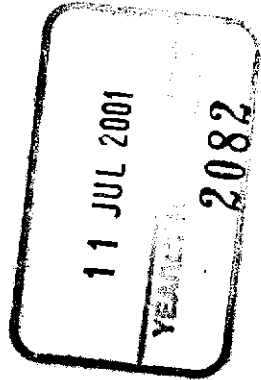

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Scapa Flow, wrecks of 4 cruisers of German High Seas Fleet comprises the remains of four vessels of the German High Seas Fleet, scuttled in Scapa Flow on 21 June 1919, together with an area of seabed around each wreck in which associated debris is scattered. The 4 vessels comprise the light cruisers Brummer, Dresden, Karlsruhe and Koln (variously spelled Koln or Coln, with or without umlaut). Three lie to the NE of the island of Cava, while one (Karlsruhe) lies to the NW. These remains along with three battleships scheduled separately, are the only surviving examples of large vessels from the interned Fleet. The areas to be scheduled consist of 4 circular areas of seabed, each 500m in diameter. These areas include the hull of each vessel and the debris field associated with each and a small area around, in which further remains may survive below the surface sediment. The monument, which lies in the County of Orkney as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.
