ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as St Cyrus, Old Parish Church consists of the remains of the late medieval church of St Cyrus. The remains consist of the South Transept of the Church, which was later used as a burial aisle for the Porteous family. The building is rectangular, measuring approximately 7m NS by 6m. The area to be scheduled extends 5 metres out from the walls. The area measures 17m NS by 16m EW. Excluded from the scheduling are those burial lairs where burial rights exist and those monuments outside the building, which are above ground. The monument, which lies in the Parish of St Cyrus and the County of Kincardine as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

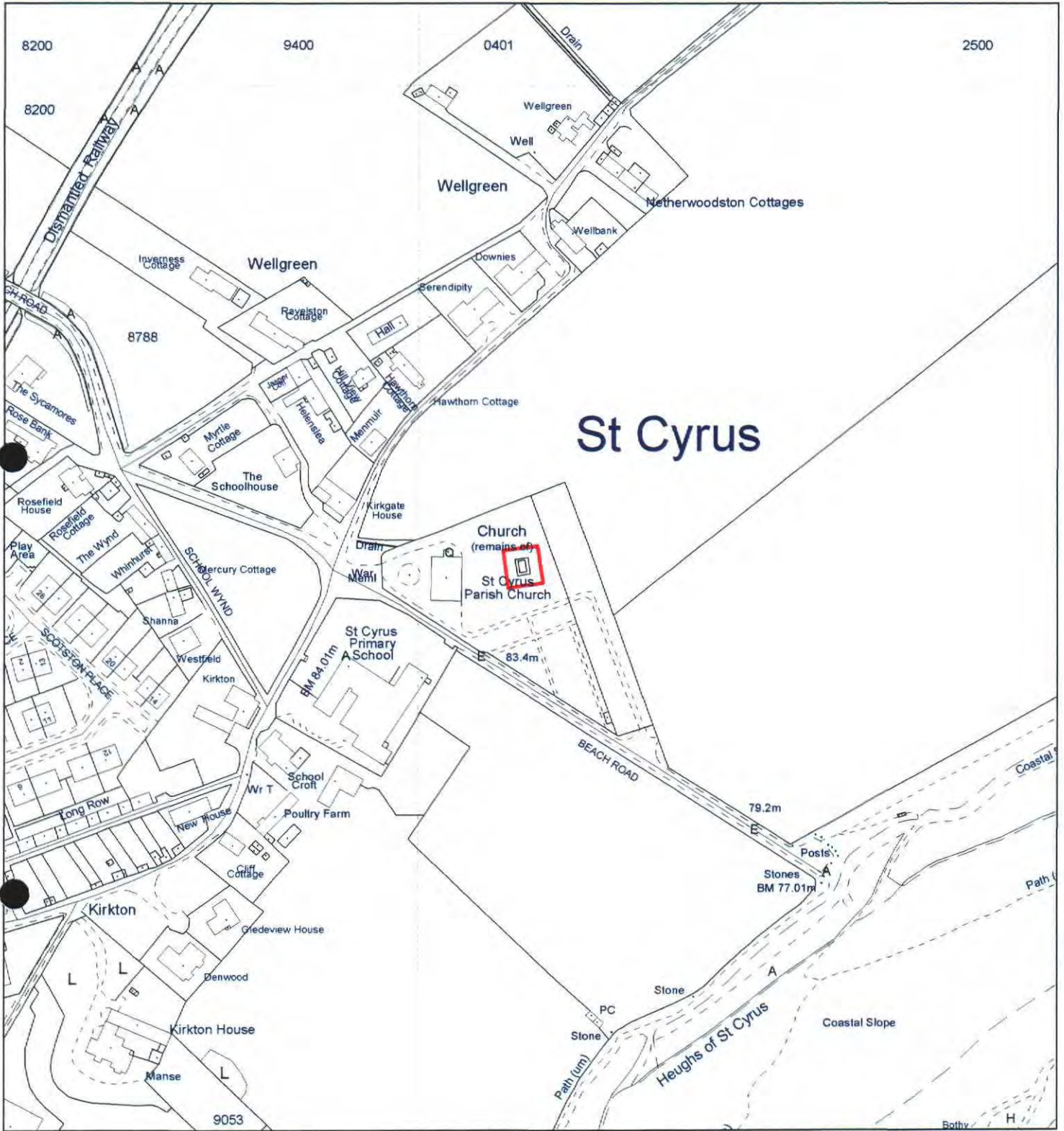


