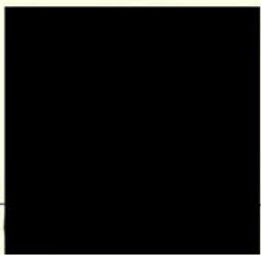


THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 10432
AMENDED ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The entry in the Schedule of monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the above Act in respect of the monument known as Dumgree Church and burial ground, dated 29 May 2003 and recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines for the County of Dumfries on 10 July 2003 is hereby in accordance with the provisions of section 1(5) of the above Act amended to delete the sentence "The boundaries are defined by the outside edge of the burial ground enclosure, including a 5m wide buffer zone around its N, E and S sides." Specifically excluded from the scheduling is the top 300mm of the track at the west side of the monument to allow for its maintenance.

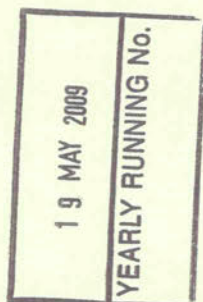

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Dumgree Church and burial ground, comprises the remains of Dumgree Church and its burial ground. The church is medieval in date, and visible as turf-covered footings. The monument is situated on the SSE flank of Park Hill, overlooking the Kinnel Water, at about 225m OD. The area to be scheduled comprises the remains described and an area around them within which related material may be found. It is irregular with maximum dimensions of 75m N-S and 83m E-W. The boundaries are defined by the outside edge of the burial ground enclosure, including a 5m wide buffer zone around its N, E and S sides. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kirkpatrick-Juxta and the County of Dumfries as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

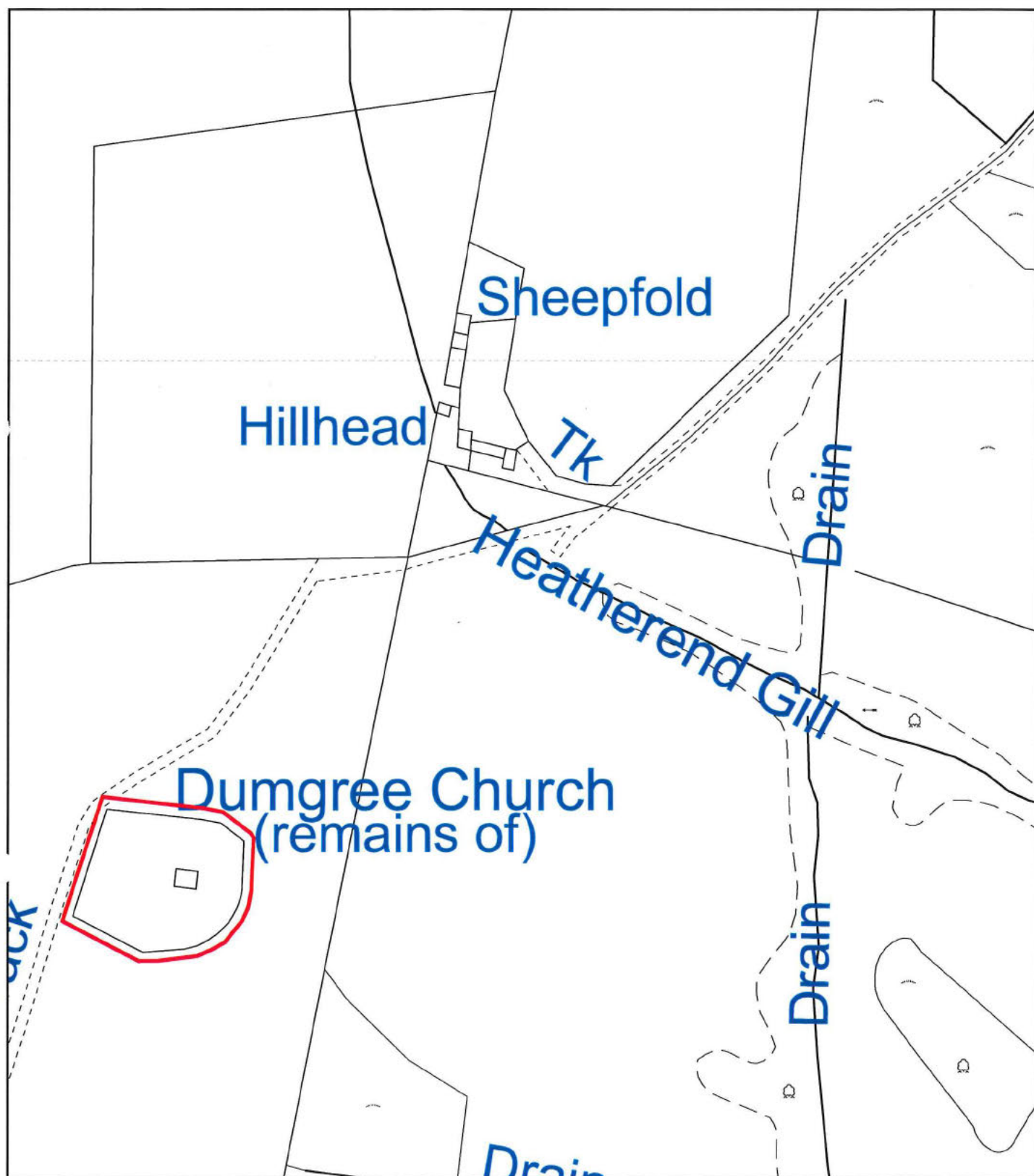
