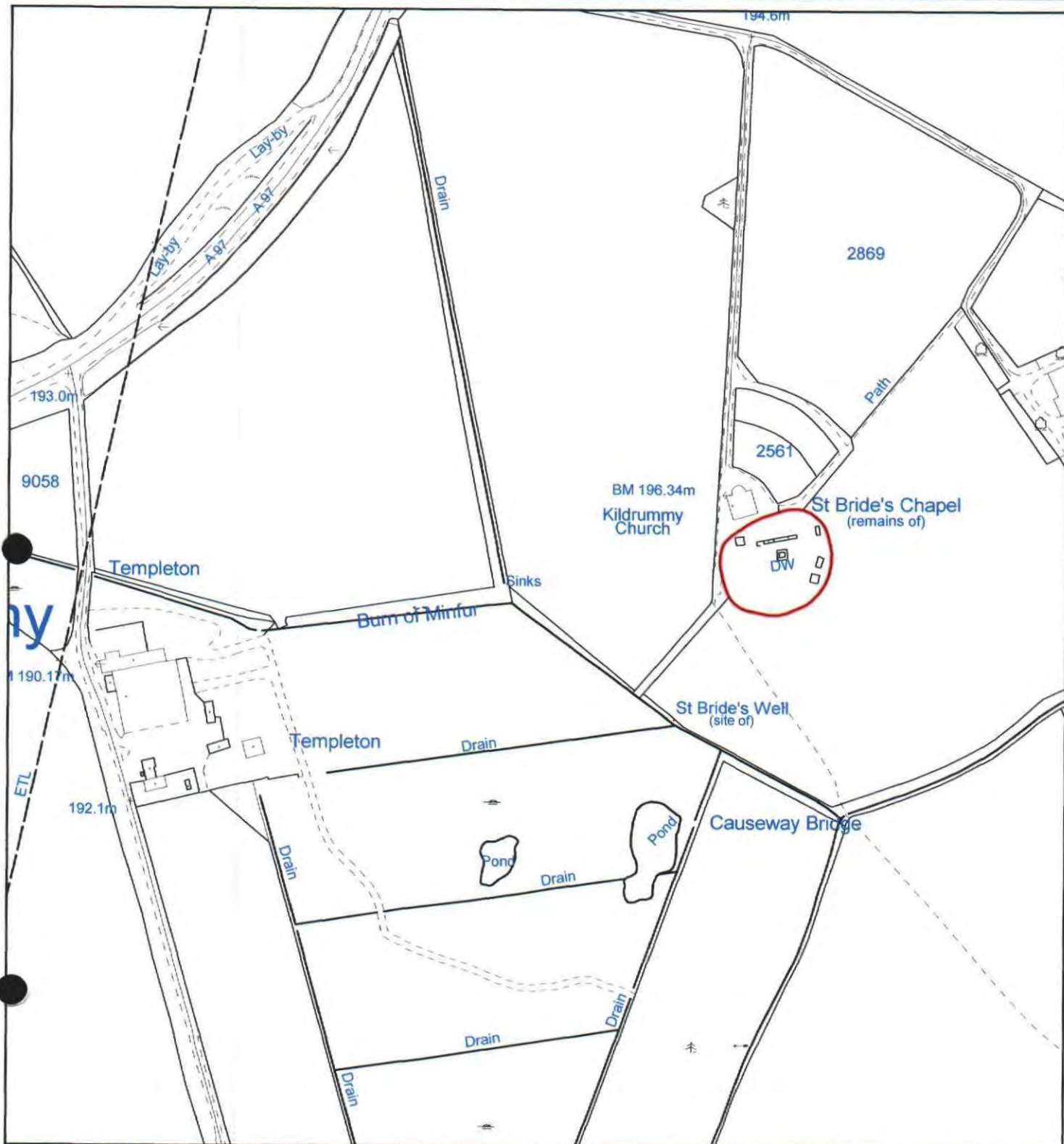
The monument known as St Bride's Chapel (Kildrummy Old Parish Church), comprises the remains of the parish church of Kildrummy and its burial ground, which is situated on top of a glacial mound within Strathdon. The church was dedicated to St Bride and appears to have been established as a parish church before 1300. The mound on which the church stands may have been the site of a motte and bailey castle (the precursor of Kildrummy Castle) before it became an ecclesiastical site. Much of the church was demolished in 1805 to build the present church, immediately to the NNE. The area to be scheduled includes the remains to the N wall of the church, the Elphinstone Aisle and the mound on which the church was located. The area which is defined on the ground by the boundary fence which encloses the site, is oval with maximum dimensions of 54m NE-SW and 50.5m E-W. The scheduling excludes all modern burial lairs still in use. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kildrummy and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]
