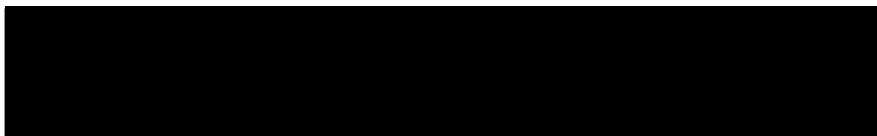
THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Maryculter House, church and burial ground 65m NNE of, comprises the remains of Maryculter Chapel and burial ground, which is also known as the Old Parish Kirk of Maryculter. The monument consists of the fragmentary remains of a medieval chapel and a walled burial ground, sitting within the grounds of Maryculter House, close to the E bank of the River Dee. The area to be scheduled includes the remains of the chapel, the burial ground and the enclosing wall. The area is irregular and is defined by the boundary wall of the burial ground. It has maximum dimensions of 65m NW-SE and 56m transversely. All modern burial lairs still in use, within and outwith the church, are excluded from the scheduling. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Maryculter and the County of Kincardine as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

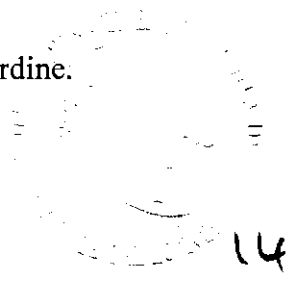
