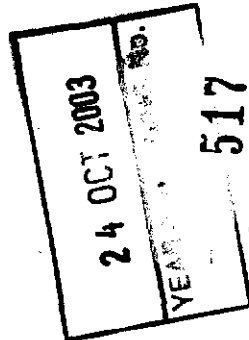

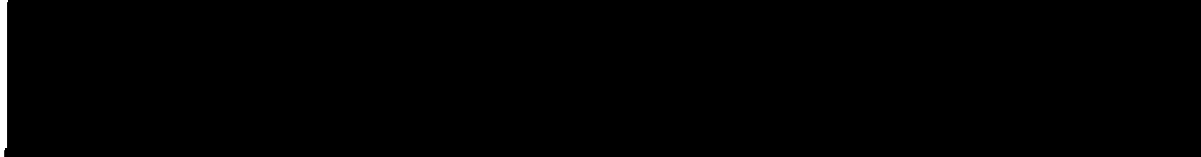
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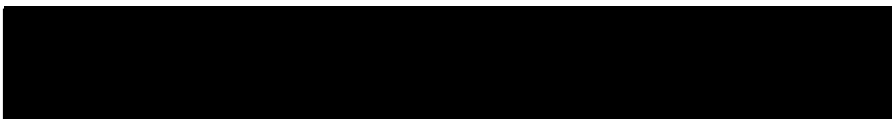

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Lee Tower, comprises the lower one and a half storeys of a defensible structure that may have been either a small tower house, or more likely a bastle. It is a rectangular structure of about 9.75m from north-east to south-west and about 7.25m from north-west to south-east, with relatively thin walls of about 1.15m in thickness. The area to be scheduled corresponds to the ground area of the upstanding part of the monument, being four-sided and measuring a maximum of 10m by 8m. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Innerleithen and the County of Peebles as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the subjects

 is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

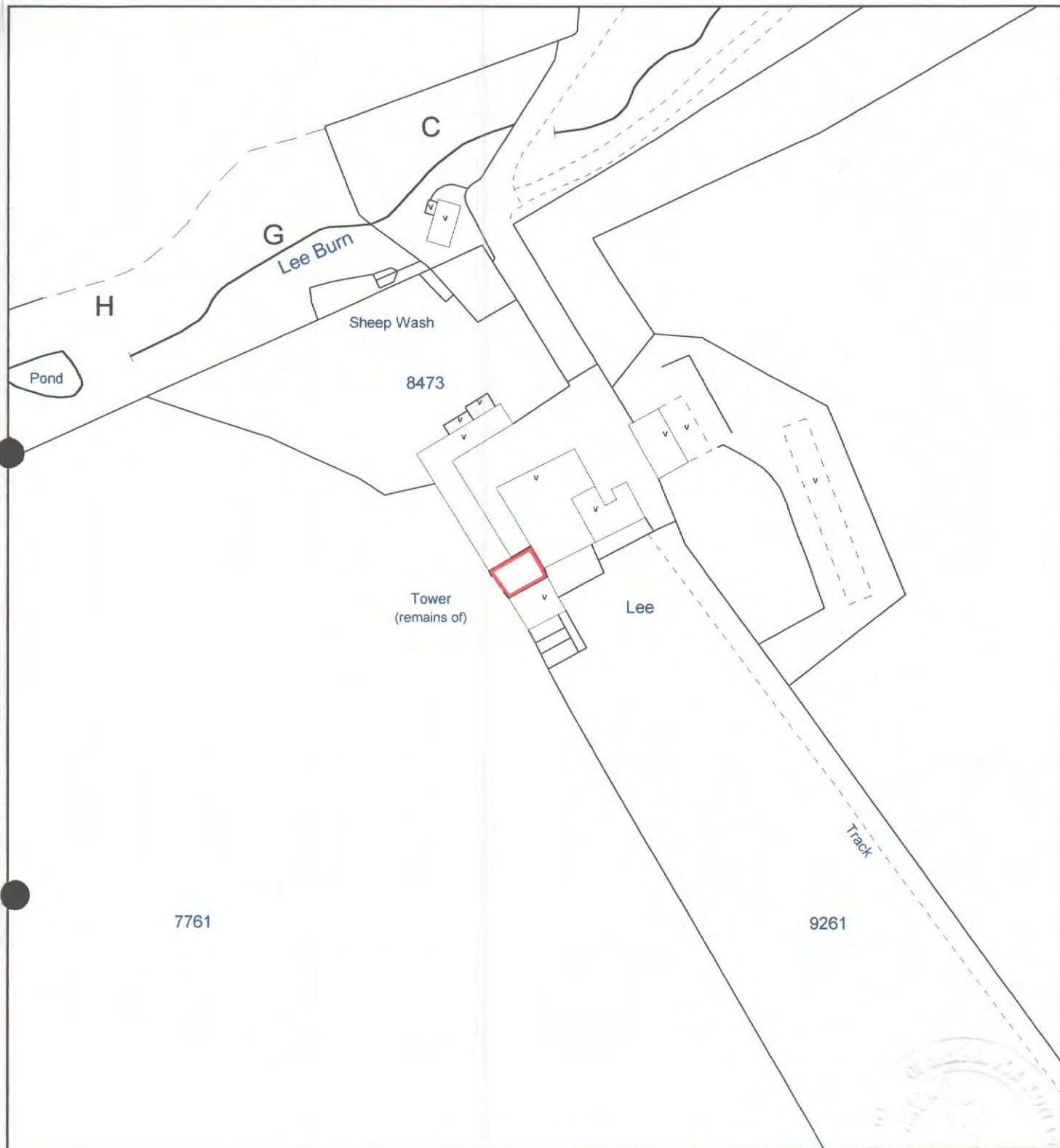
