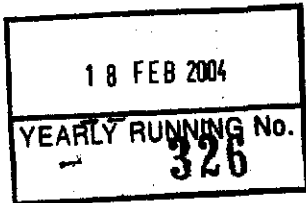

The monument known as Dun Toiseach, dun 300m SE of Torran Farm, comprises the remains of a dun, a hilltop fortification of late prehistoric date, set on a rocky knoll overlooking the S end of Loch Awe. The area to be scheduled is an irregular oval, measuring a maximum of 45m between its most northerly and its most southerly points and a maximum of 40m transversely. This includes the dun and a small area outside its walls in which evidence relating to its construction and occupation is likely to survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kilmartin and the County of Argyll as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and

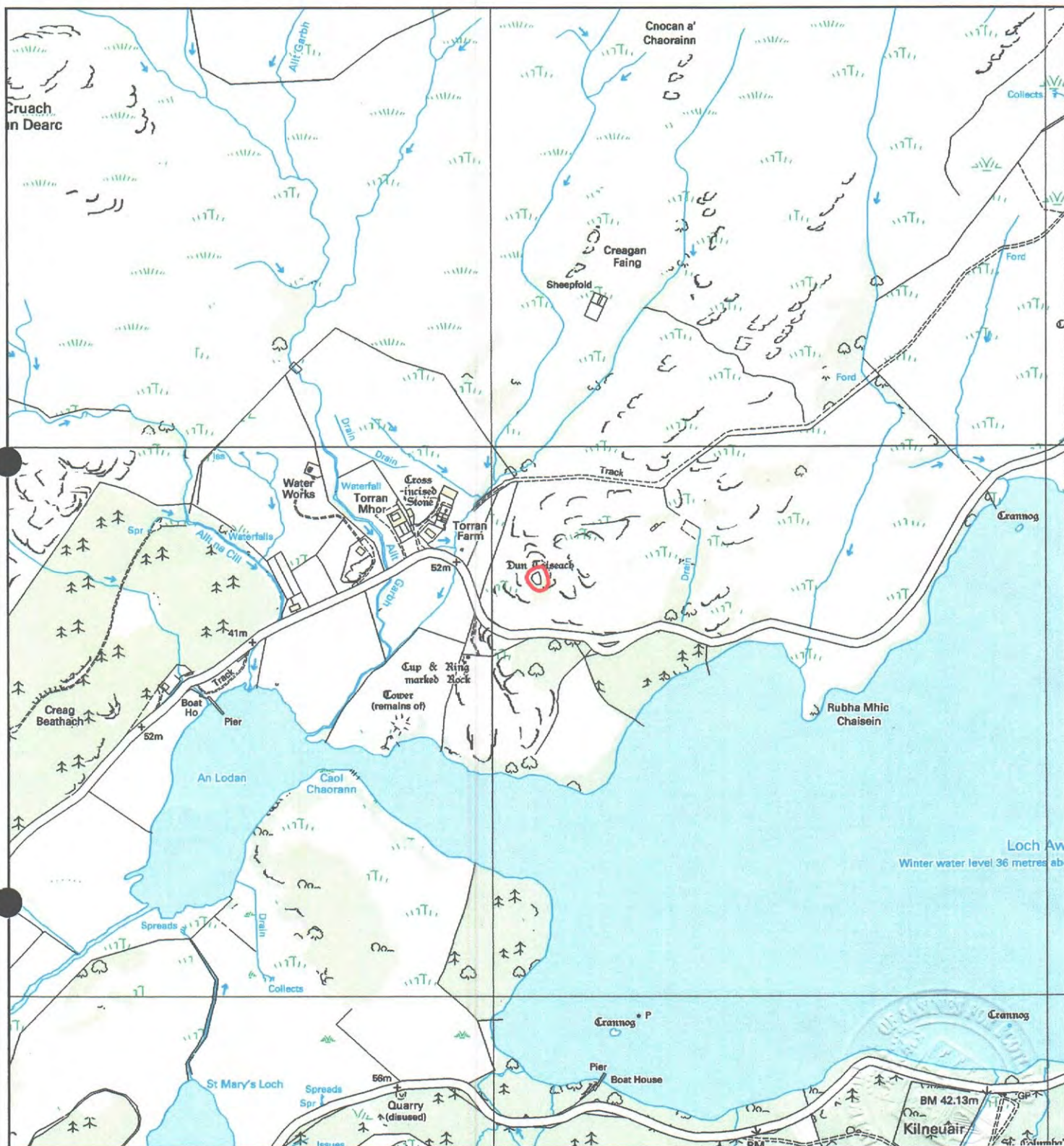
