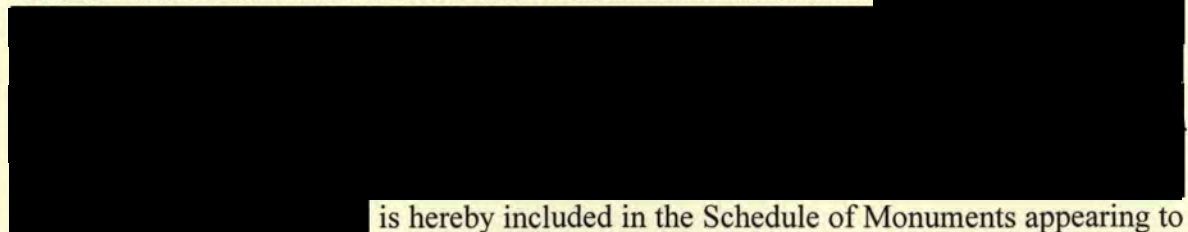

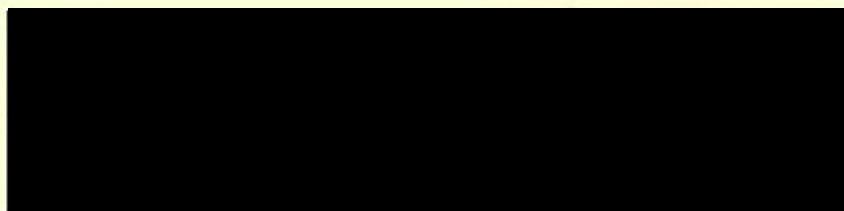

The monument known as Muirton, bank barrow, souterrains and enclosures 350m WSW of, comprises the remains of a bank barrow, souterrains, ring ditches, pit circles with souterrains attached, and other features of prehistoric date, visible as cropmarks on oblique aerial photographs. The area to be scheduled comprises the remains described and an area around and between them within which related material may be expected to be found. It is rectangular with maximum dimensions of 560m NNW to SSE by 300m transversely, bounded on the SE and SW sides by fences, which are themselves excluded from the scheduling. The boundaries to the west and south are defined by the boundary fence, which is itself excluded from the designated area. The above ground elements of the fence that runs from west to east through the monument is also excluded from the scheduled area. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Drainie and the County of Moray as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

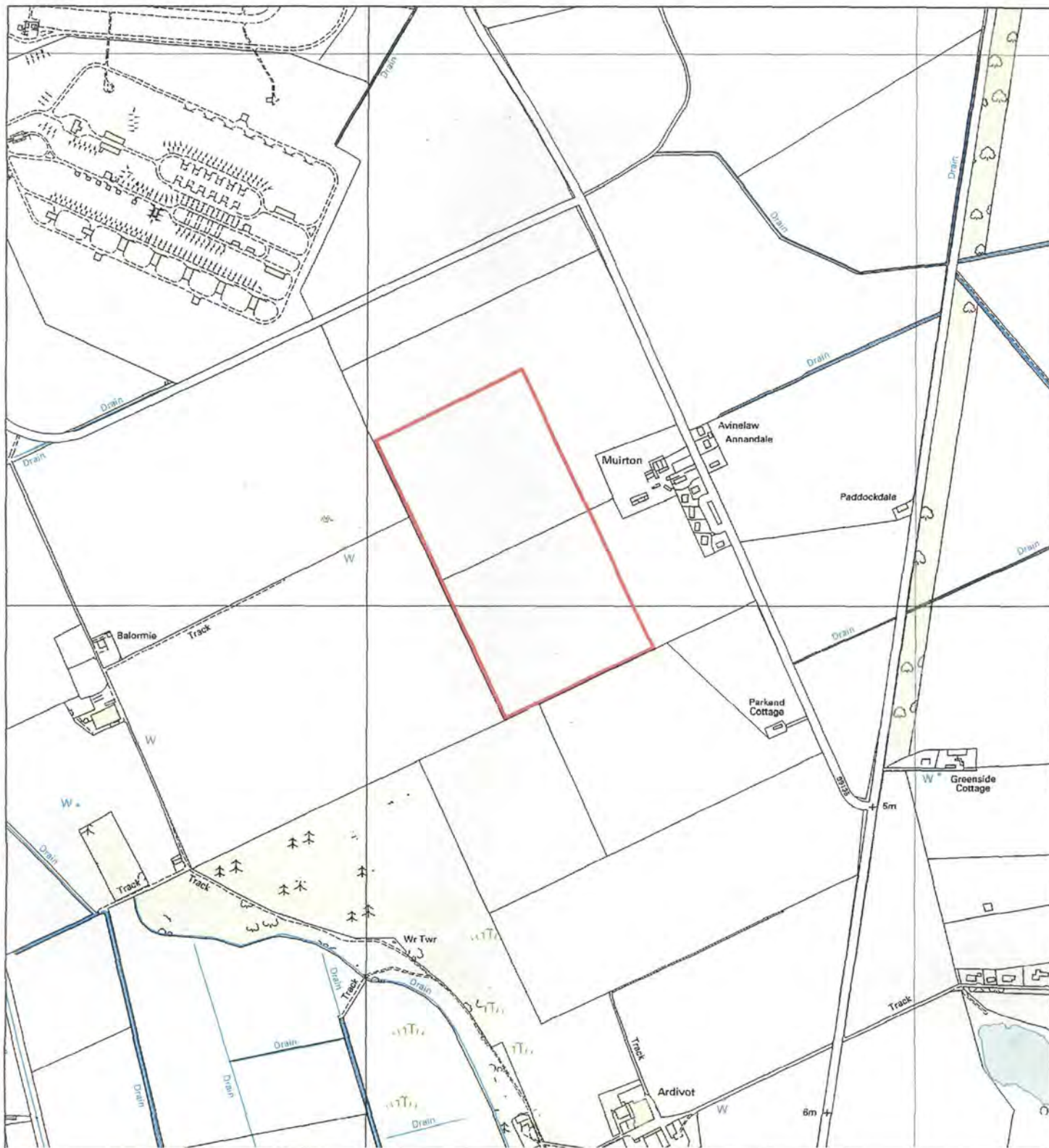
