



THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979

The monument known as Law of Melrose, cairn, comprises a cairn of prehistoric date, visible as an upstanding earth-and-stone mound. Cairns such as this are funerary and ritual monuments built during the Early Bronze Age (c.2500-1500BC). The area to be scheduled comprises the remains described and an area around them within which related material may be expected to be found. It is circular, measuring 40m in diameter and centred on the cairn. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Gamrie and the County of Banff as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

 is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

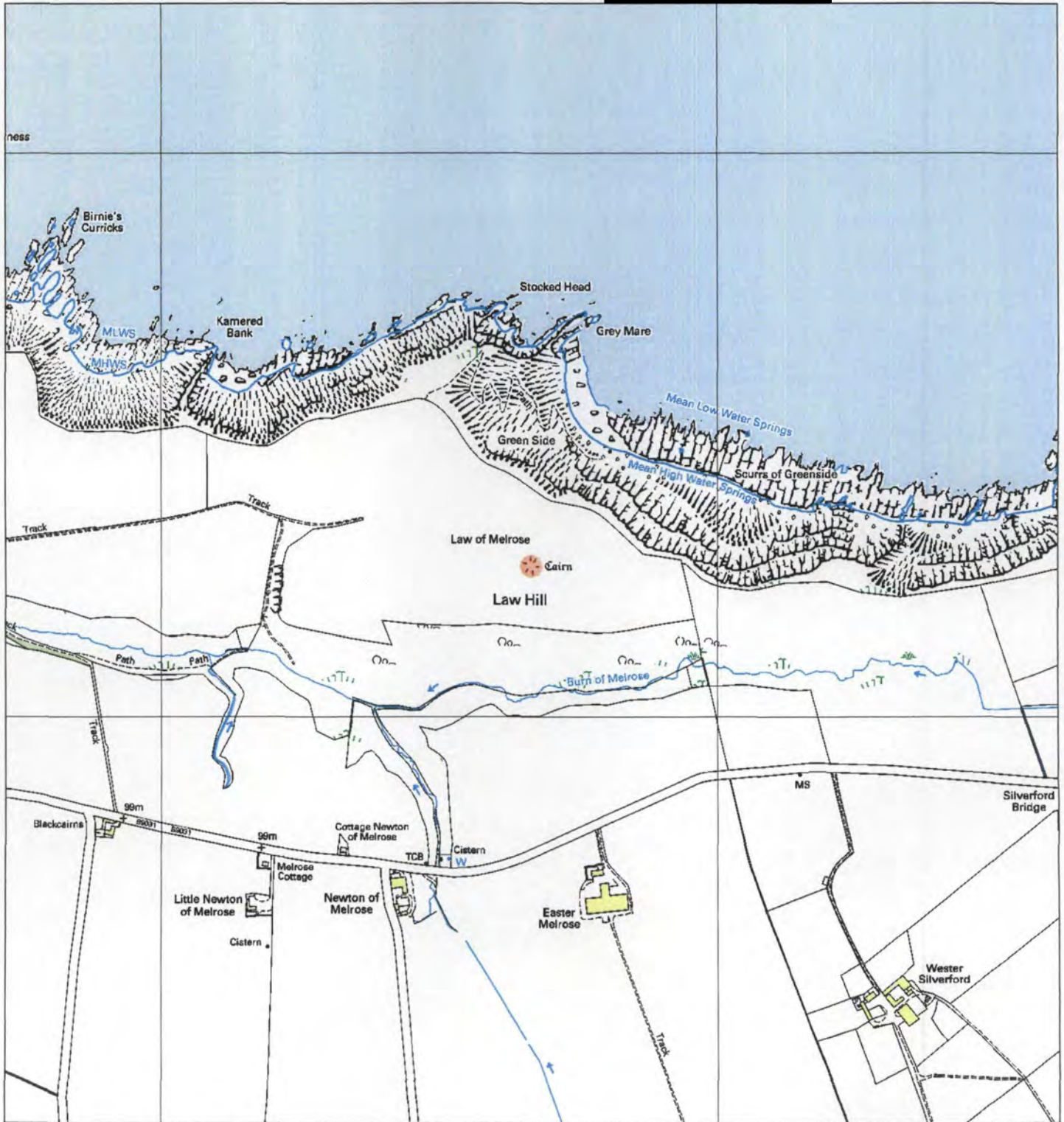

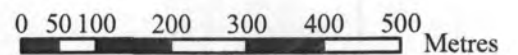


Representation of the Scheduled Area
