The monument known as Tronach Castle, Tronach Head, Portknockie, comprises the remains of a fort or castle, of prehistoric or medieval date, occupying a rocky pinnacle, now almost separated from the cliffs to the south. The area to be scheduled is irregular and measures 100m NE-SW by 25m NW-SE, to include the visible structures and the entire top of the pinnacle. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Rathven and the County of Banff as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

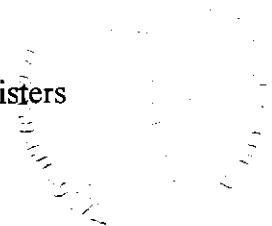

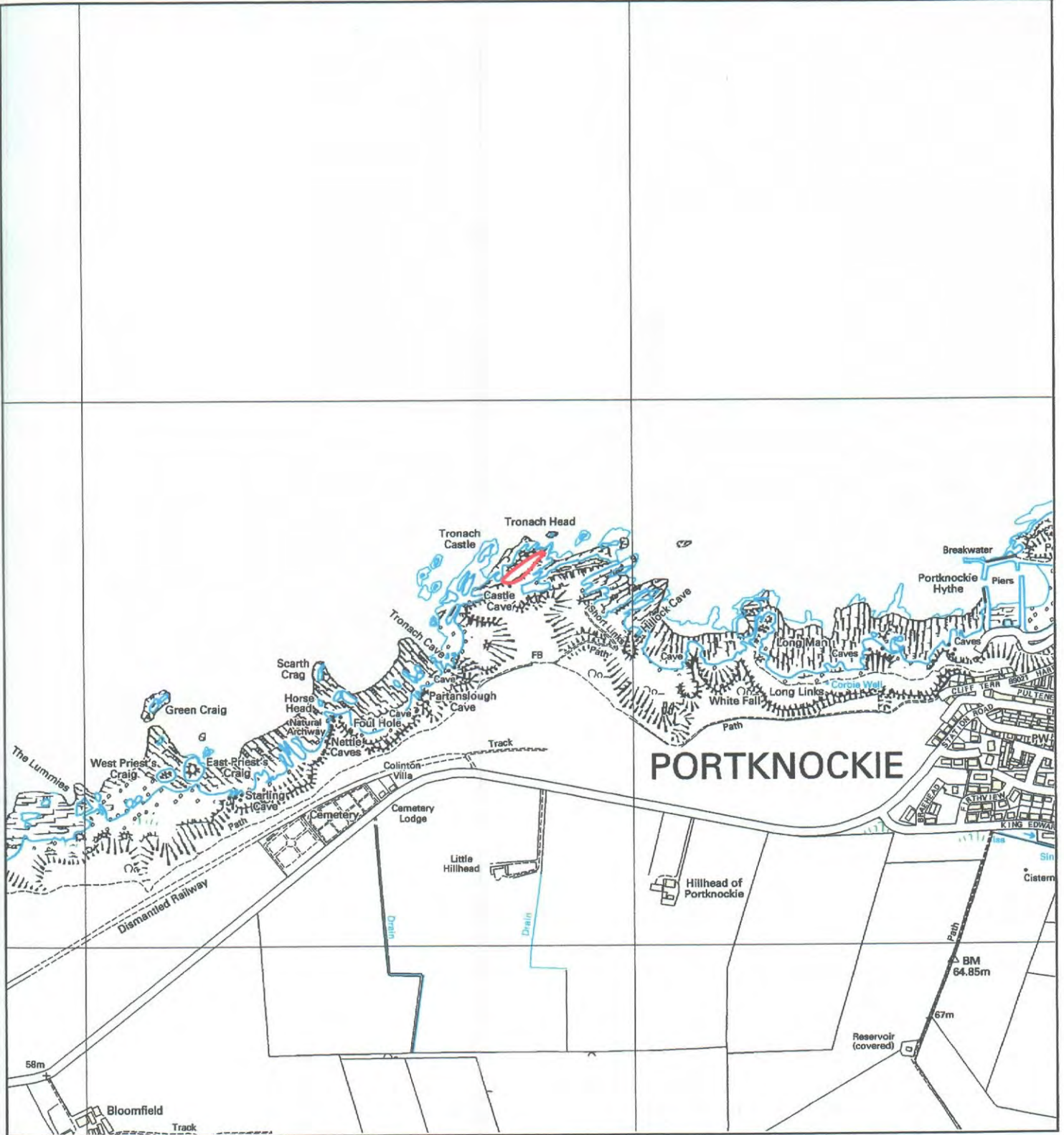
