The monument known as Ha' Hillock, motte, comprises the remains of a motte, a medieval castle hill, situated on the western edge of the steep-sided gully of the Ha' Burn. The area to be scheduled measures 75m from its northernmost to its southernmost point, and 50m E-W, to include the motte mound, the ditch, the adjacent gully, and an area around where features associated with the construction and use of the motte are likely to survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Deskford and the County of Banff as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

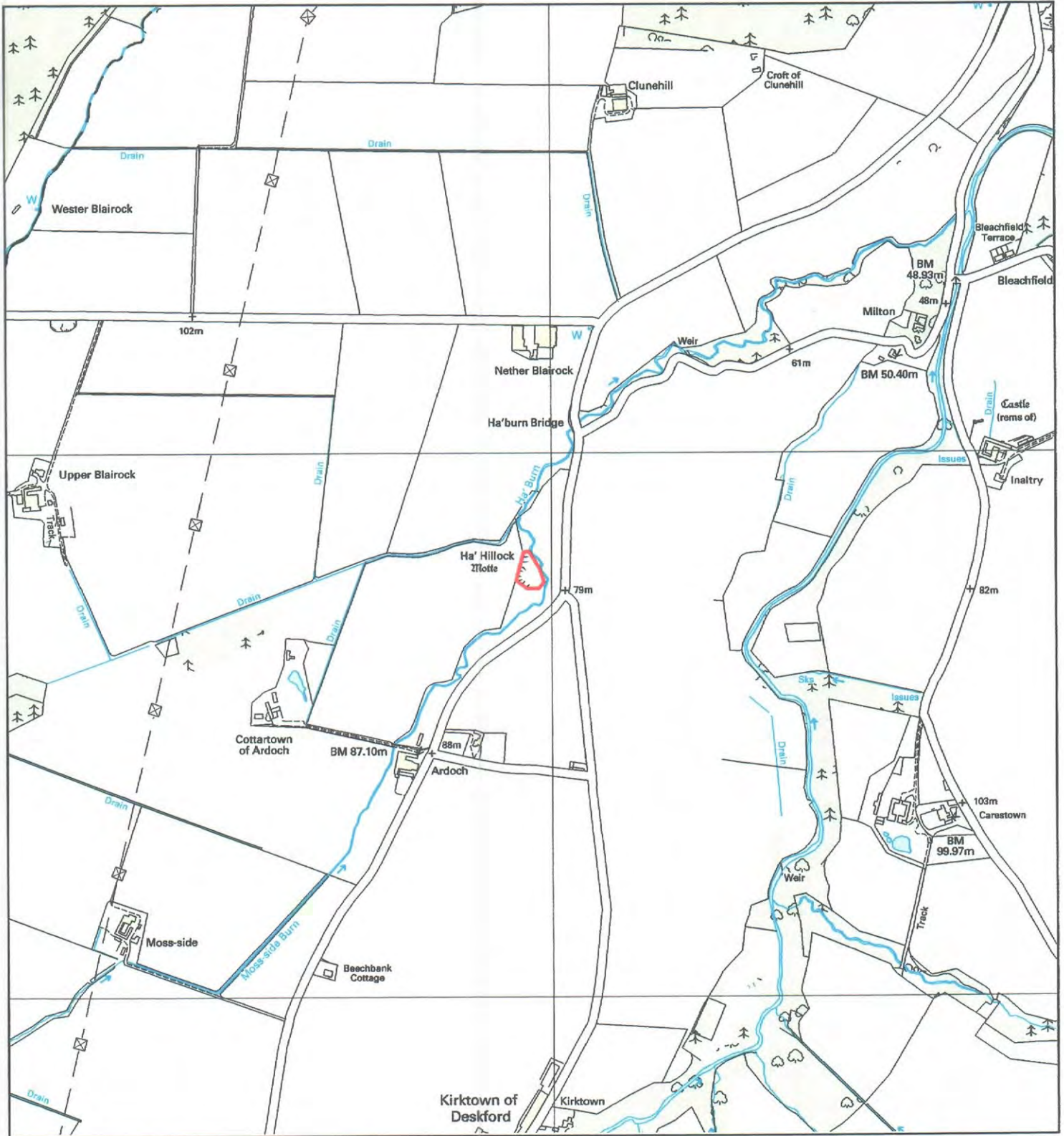
