The monument known as Wigtown Castle, comprises the remains of Wigtown Castle, a royal castle, which is early Medieval in date and is visible as an earthwork. The monument is located in a field, 300m NW of the River Bladnoch, and 150m NE of the Station Road/Harbour Road junction on the E side of Wigtown burgh. The area to be scheduled comprises the remains described including an area around them within which related archaeological material may be found. It is circular with a diameter of 175m. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Wigtown and the County of Wigtown as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

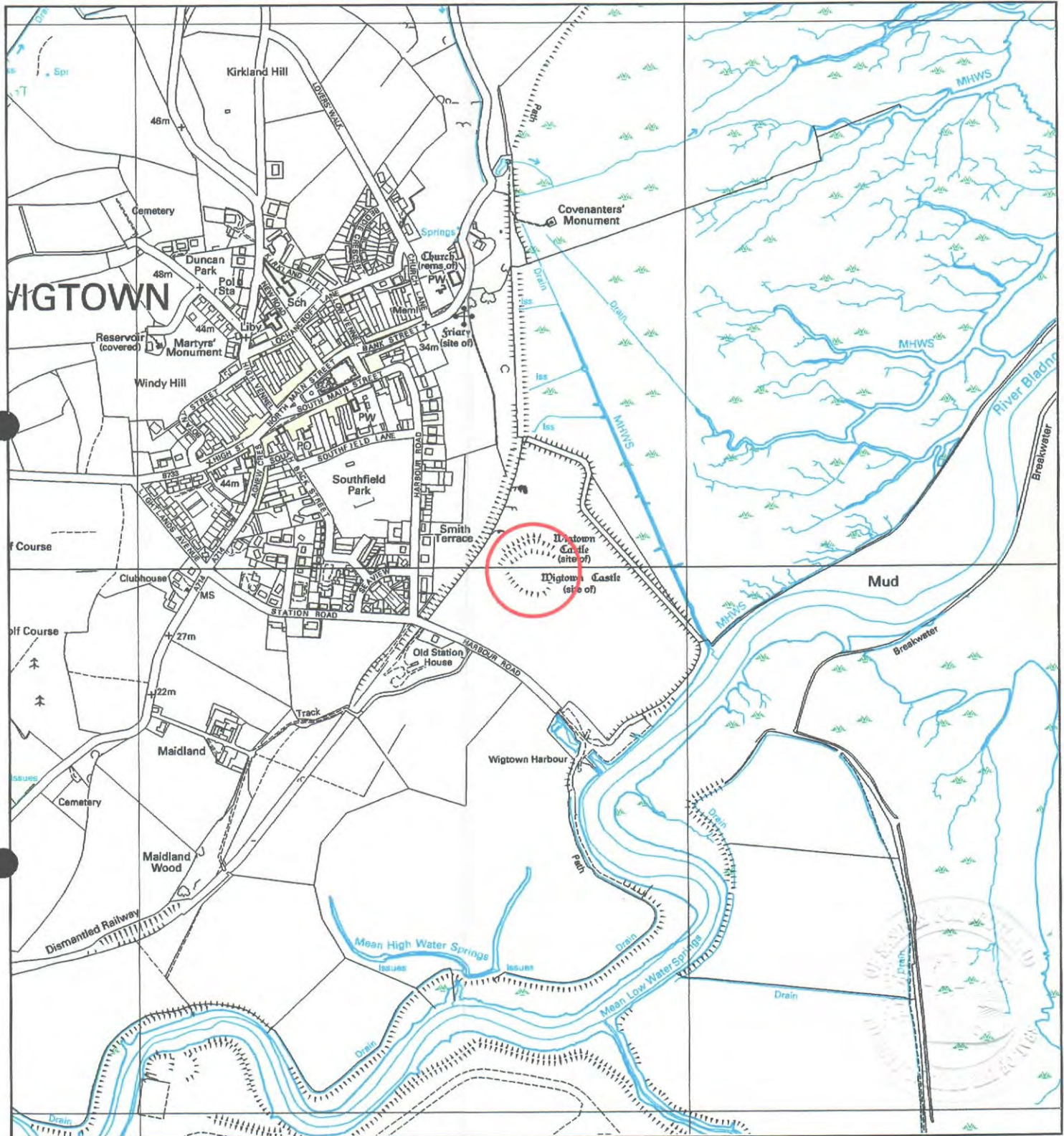
