



THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Inaltry, castle 30m NNW of, comprises the remains of a masonry castle situated on land rising to the E of the Burn of Deskford. The area to be scheduled includes the upstanding wall and an area surrounding the wall where associated archaeology could be expected to survive. The area is rectangular and has maximum dimensions of 30m ENE-WSW and 30m transversely. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Deskford and the County of Banff as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

 hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.
