



THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Law Cairn, 300m NE of West Craigmaud, comprises the remains of a substantial prehistoric burial cairn surrounded and contained by a modern drystone wall. The area to be scheduled is a circle measuring 40m in diameter, centred on the mound. The top 50cm of the track to the east is specifically excluded from the scheduling, to allow for maintenance. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Tyrie and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

 hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.


