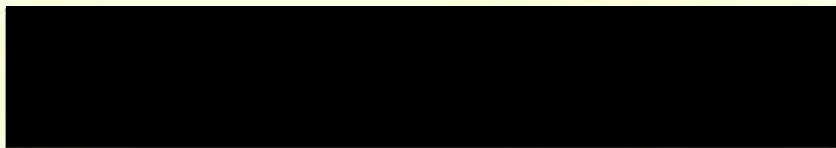

The monument known as Castlethorn, fort and standing stones 500m ESE of Torphichen Mains, comprises a prehistoric hillfort which is situated on the top of a knoll known as Castlethorn. The area to be scheduled measures a maximum of 108m W-E by 88m N-S, to include the fort, standing stones and an area around it in which remains associated with its construction and use are likely to survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Torphichen and the County of West Lothian as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

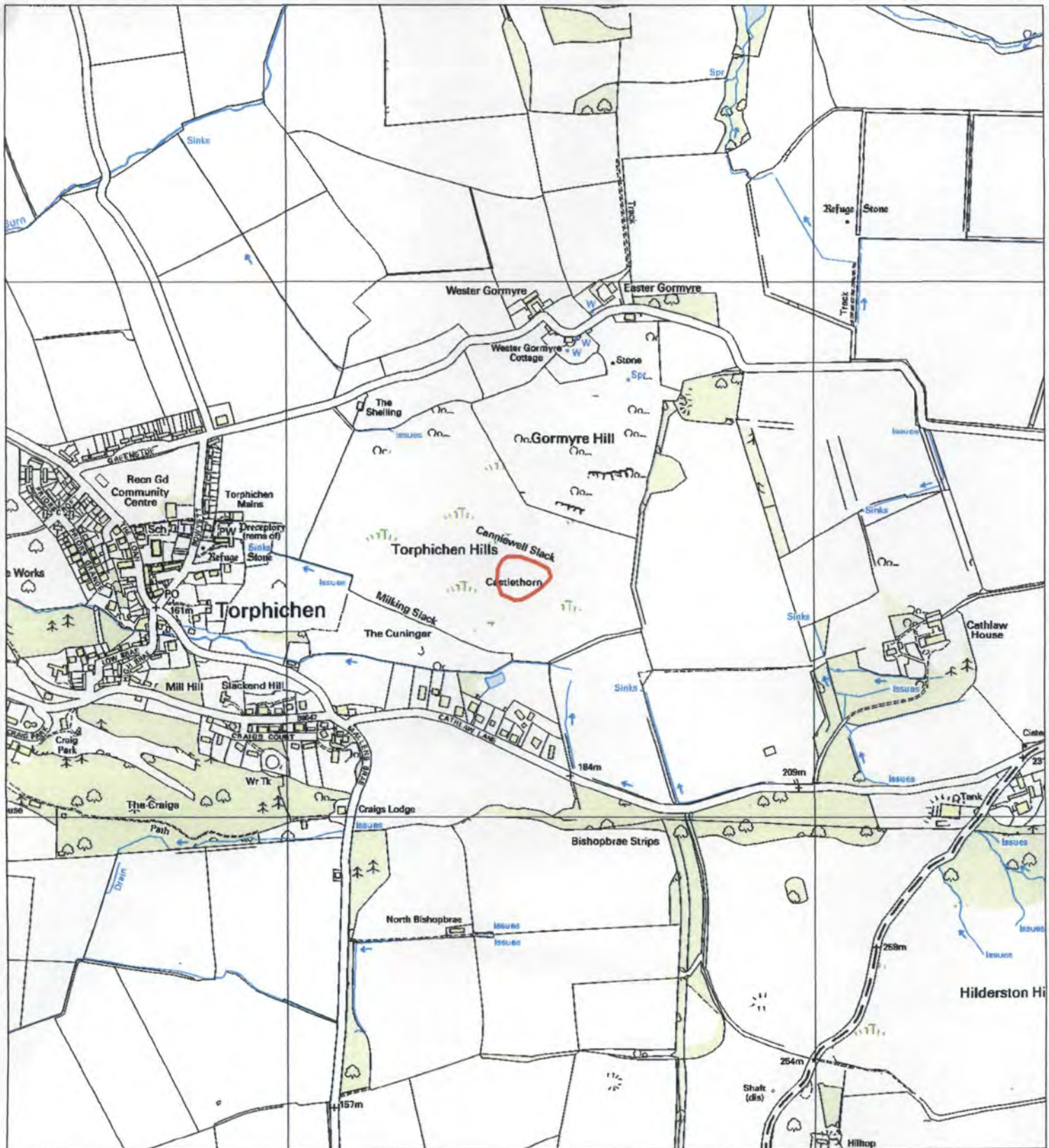
