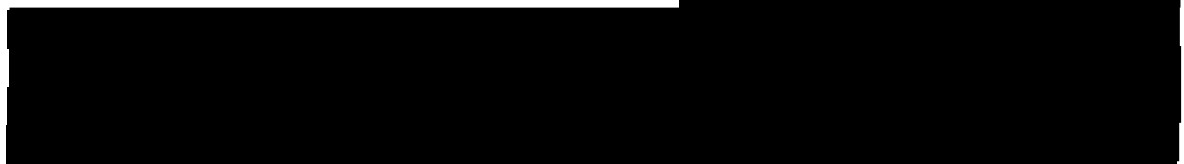


THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

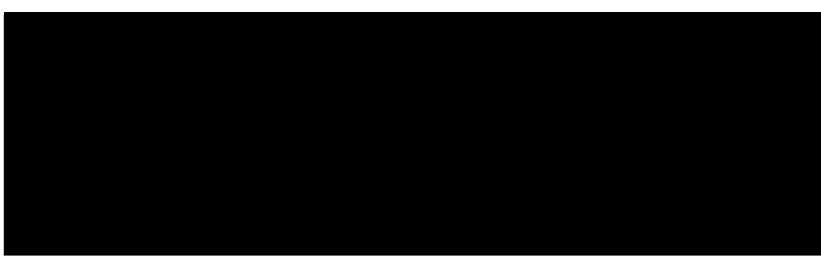

The monument known as Loch nic Ruaidhe, dun, Barra, comprises the remains of a later prehistoric (Iron Age) island dun, situated in Loch nic Ruaidhe on Barra. The area to be scheduled is irregular measuring 58m from N-S by 40m transversely, to include the dun, its causeway and an area around in which associated remains may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Barra and the County of Inverness as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

Subscribed by Malcolm Cooper, Chief Inspector with Historic Scotland, being an officer of the Scottish Ministers at Edinburgh on the 8 day of NOVEMBER Two thousand and five, before this witness Victoria Ball, of Longmore House, Salisbury Place, Edinburgh.

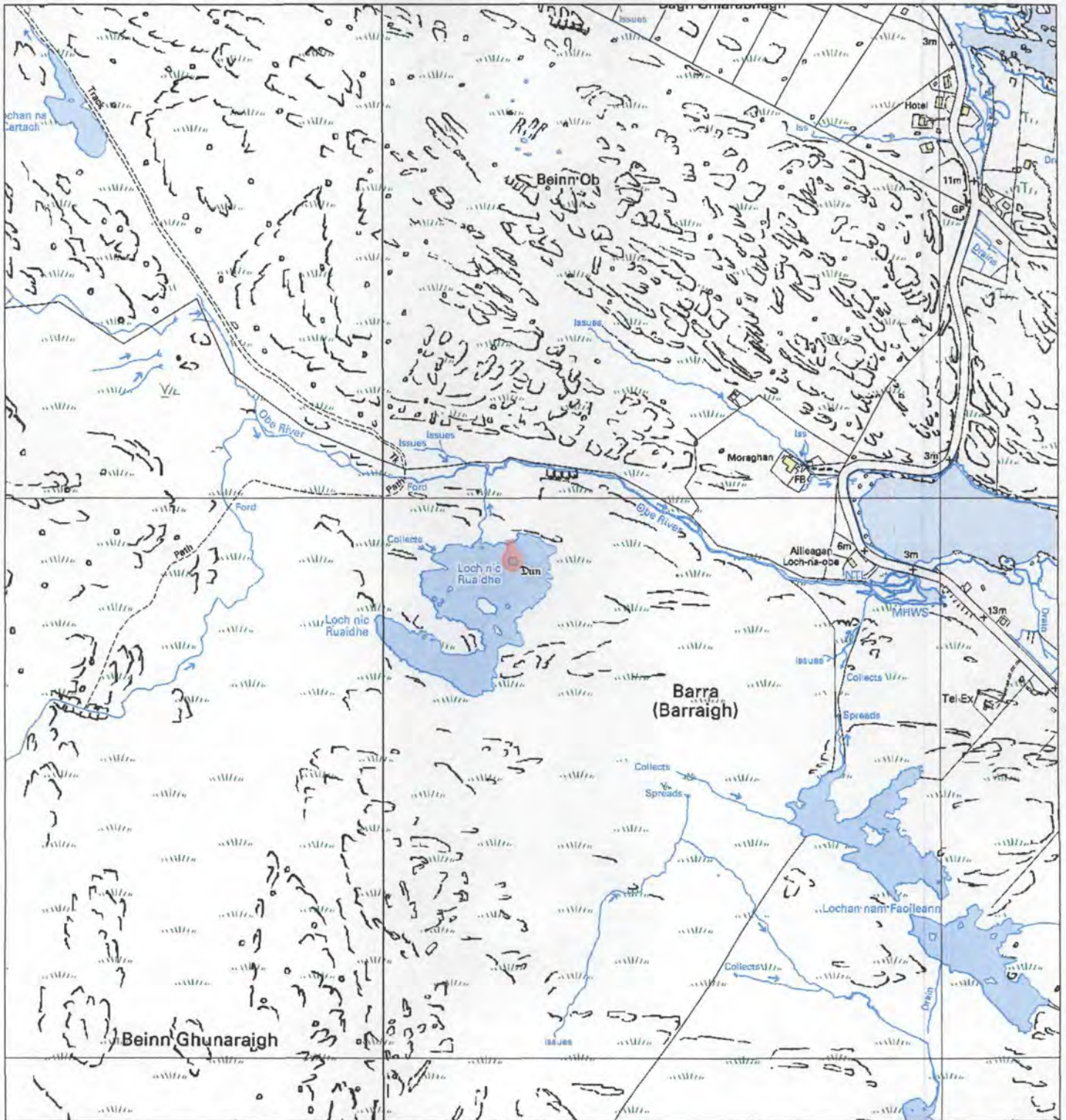
