The monument known as Burgi Geos, promontory fort, comprises a promontory fort of later prehistoric, perhaps Iron Age, date. The monument occupies a long sinuous promontory between the deep and precipitous North and South Burgi geos with cliffs 60m high, and is situated on the remote and deserted west coast of Yell. The area to be scheduled encompasses the visible remains and an area around them in which traces of associated activity may be expected to survive. It is irregular with maximum dimensions of 95m from its westernmost point due east, and 45m due N-S. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Yell and the Counties of Orkney and Zetland as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

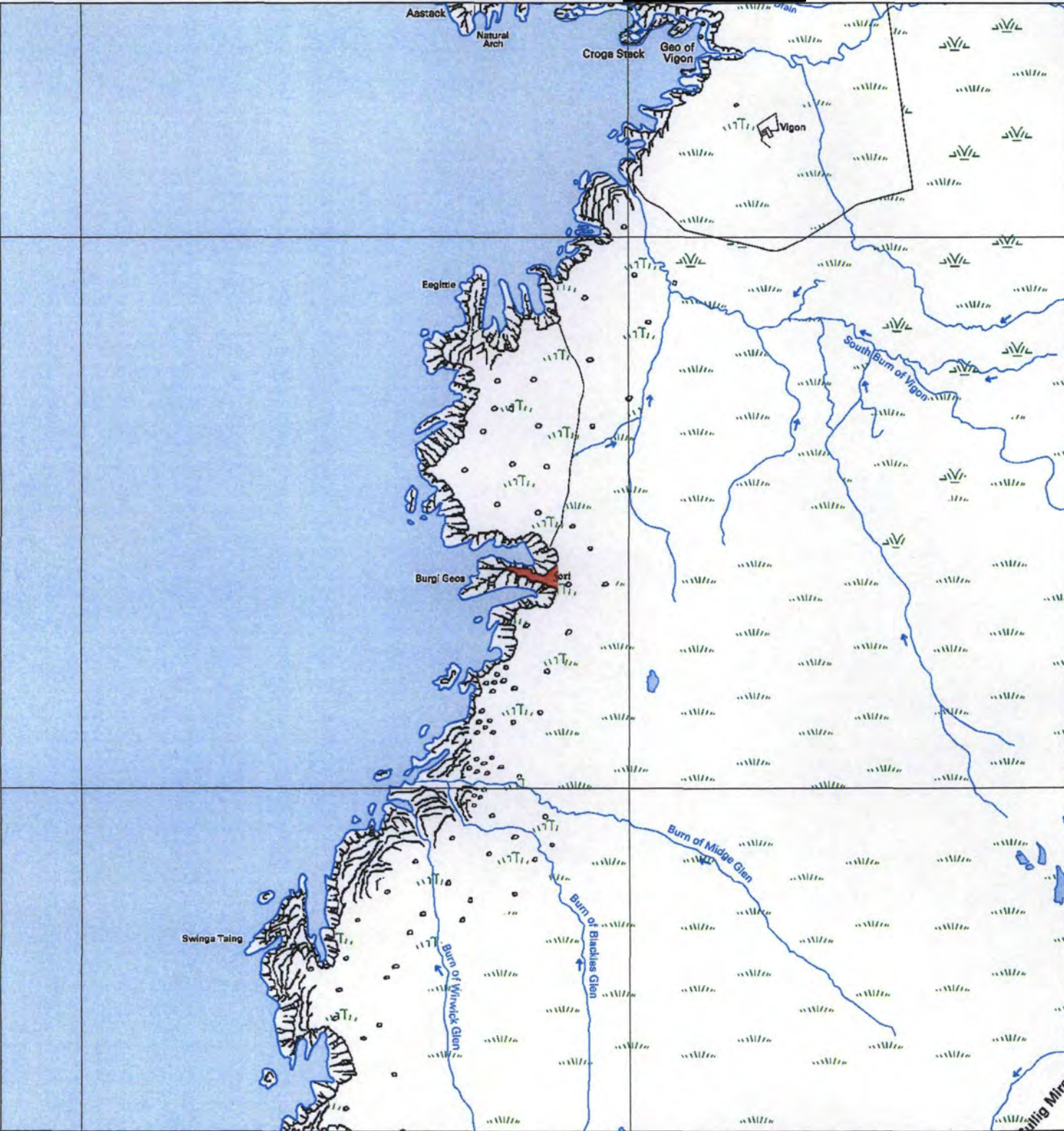

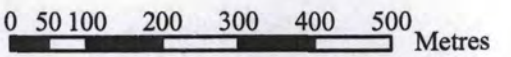

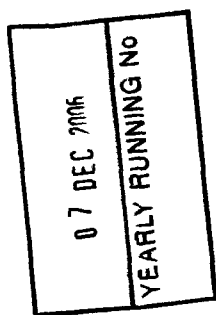
