




The monument known as Asloun Castle, comprises of a round tower part of a larger building, the bulk of which lay to the SW of the tower. The tower now serves as an 'eye-catcher' in the grounds of Asloun House. The area to be scheduled has maximum dimensions of 22m from W to E and 34m from N to S. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Alford and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

 hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.
