

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Newe's Craig, still 3950m NE of Morven Lodge, comprises a small, sunken hut interpreted as the site of an illicit still dating to the 18th or early 19th centuries. It is characteristically isolated and well concealed, in a small gully to the NW of the Deskry Water. The structure measures 3.5m from NE-SW by 3m transversely, within revetting drystone walls 0.7m thick and at least 1.2m high. The area to be scheduled is circular, centred on the structure, to include the remains described and an area around in which evidence relating to its construction and use may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Strathdon and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

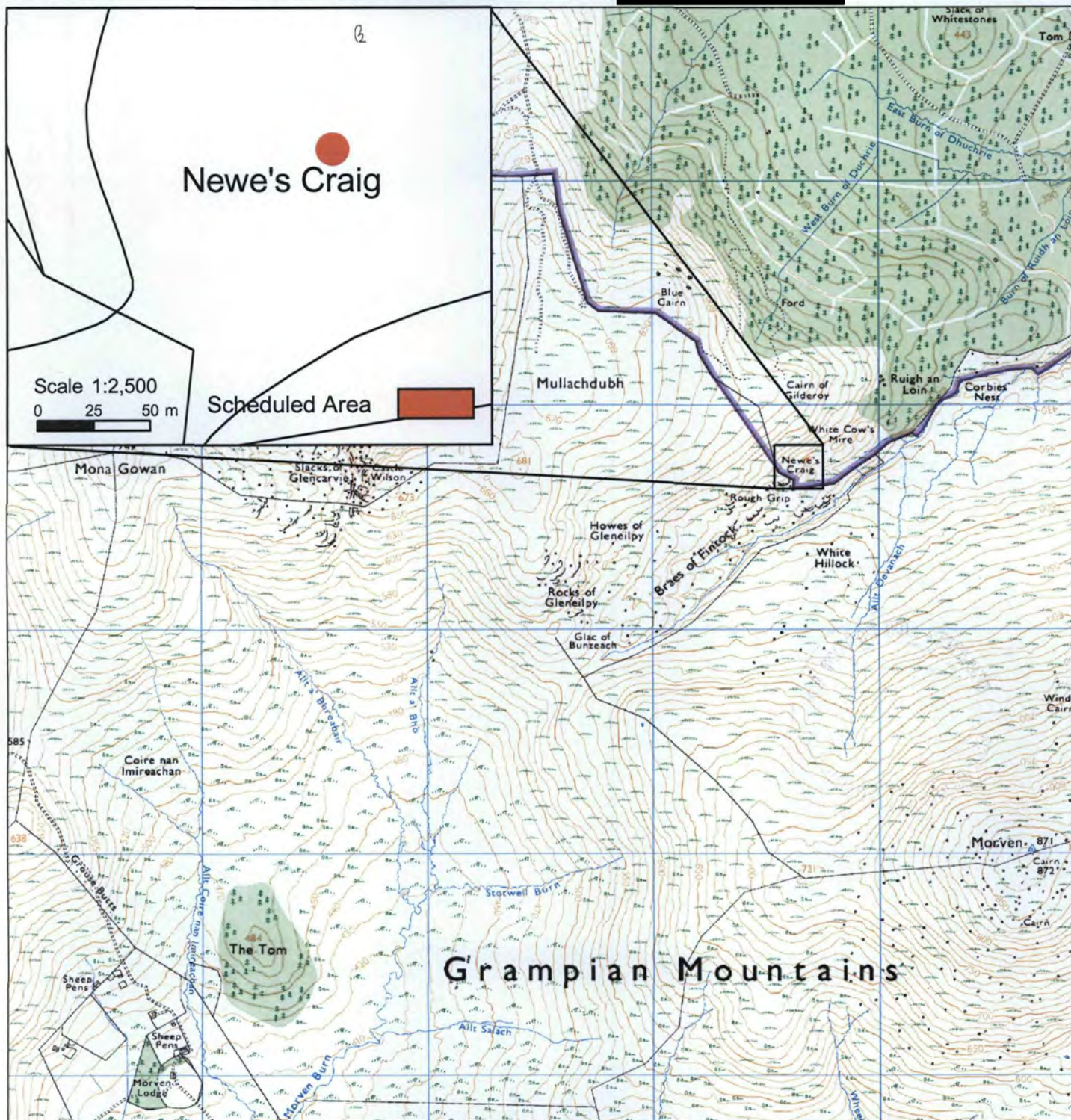

 Scheduled Area

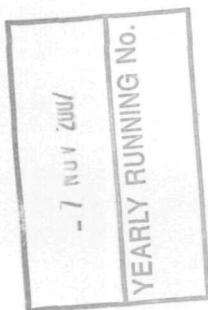
