The monument known as Migvie Castle, comprises the visible remains of Migvie Castle, the principal stronghold of the lordship of Cromar, one of the three lordships in the Earldom of Mar. It lies on the top of a hillock 250m S of Migvie parish church at 260m OD and is covered by rough grass and broom scrub. It measures 45m from NW-SE by 23m transversely. The section at the W end survives up to 0.9m high and 1.8m wide. The area to be scheduled is sub-rectangular, to include the visible remains and an area around in which evidence relating to their construction and use may survive. The scheduling excludes the above-ground elements of existing fences and the wooden telegraph pole, to allow for their maintenance. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Logie-Coldstone and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

Scheduled Area

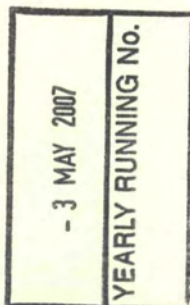
