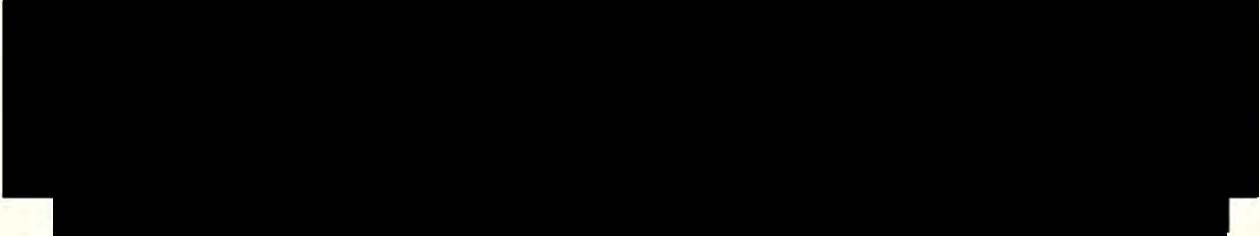


THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

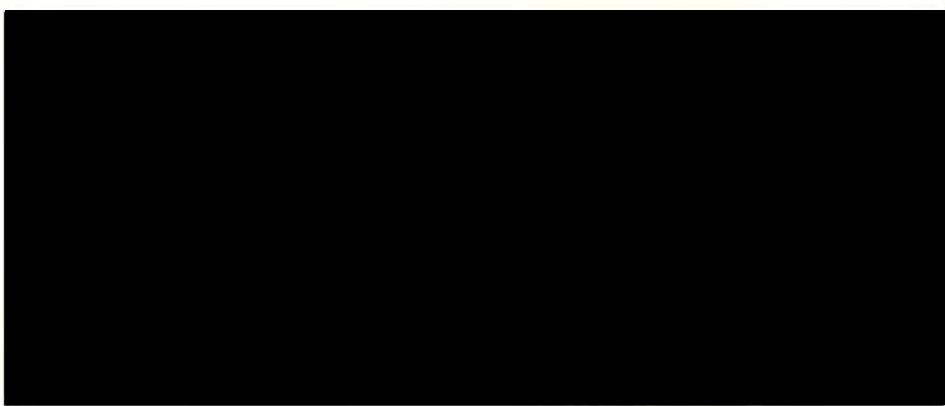

The monument known as Bressachoil farmstead, Glen Ernan, comprises the remains of Bressachoil, a farmstead that originated in the 16th century or earlier and developed over a period that ran into the 20th century, when it failed. It lies on the N slope of Glen Ernan. The monument consists of the remains of 12 buildings, including a threshing mill and a limekiln, and enclosures. The buildings range in length from 6m to 39m and in width from 2m to 11m, within walls up to 1m in thickness. Several associated enclosures remain and these are included in the scheduling. The area to be scheduled is irregular on plan, to include the remains described and an area around them within which related material may be expected to be found. Specifically excluded from the scheduling to allow for their maintenance are, the above-ground elements of the fence running across the monument, the top 30cm of the modern track and a single wooden trap set into the monument by the current fenceline. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Strathdon and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

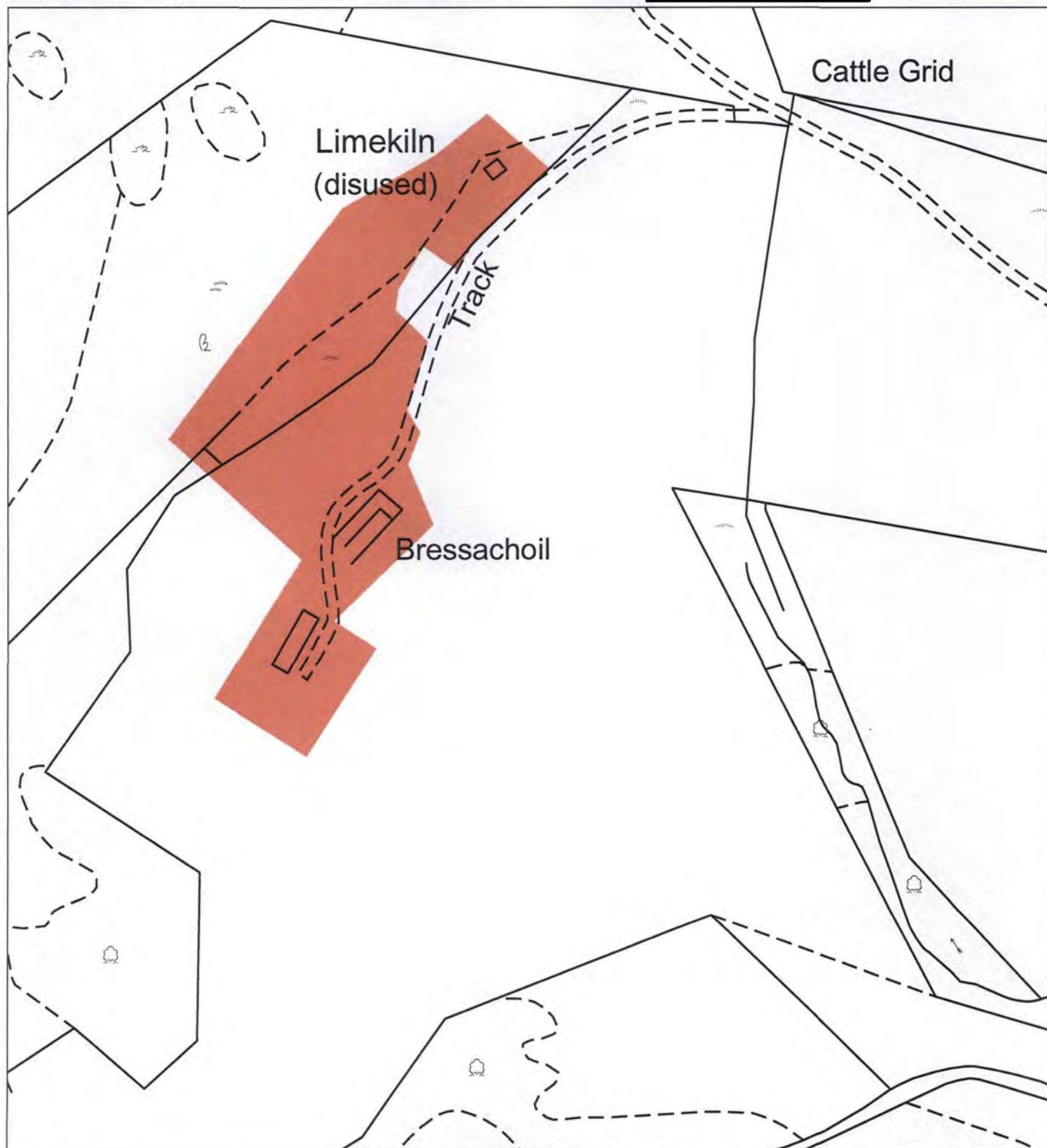

Scheduled Area

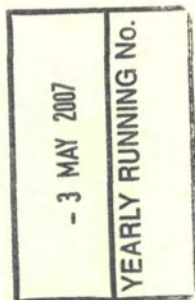
