


THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Delachuper, farmstead 310m N of, comprises the remains of Badenshilloch, a farmstead that originated in the 18th century and developed over a period that ran into the 19th century. Visible as a series of upstanding walls, banks and other features, the monument lies to the NE of the River Don. The visible, upstanding remains of the monument comprise five buildings and a stack yard. The buildings range in length from 6m to 39m and in width from 2m to 11m, within walls up to 1m thick. Several associated enclosures remain and these are included in the scheduling. The area to be scheduled comprises three discrete areas (two rectangular and one irregular), to include the remains described and an area around them within which evidence for their construction and use may be expected to survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Strathdon and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

 is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

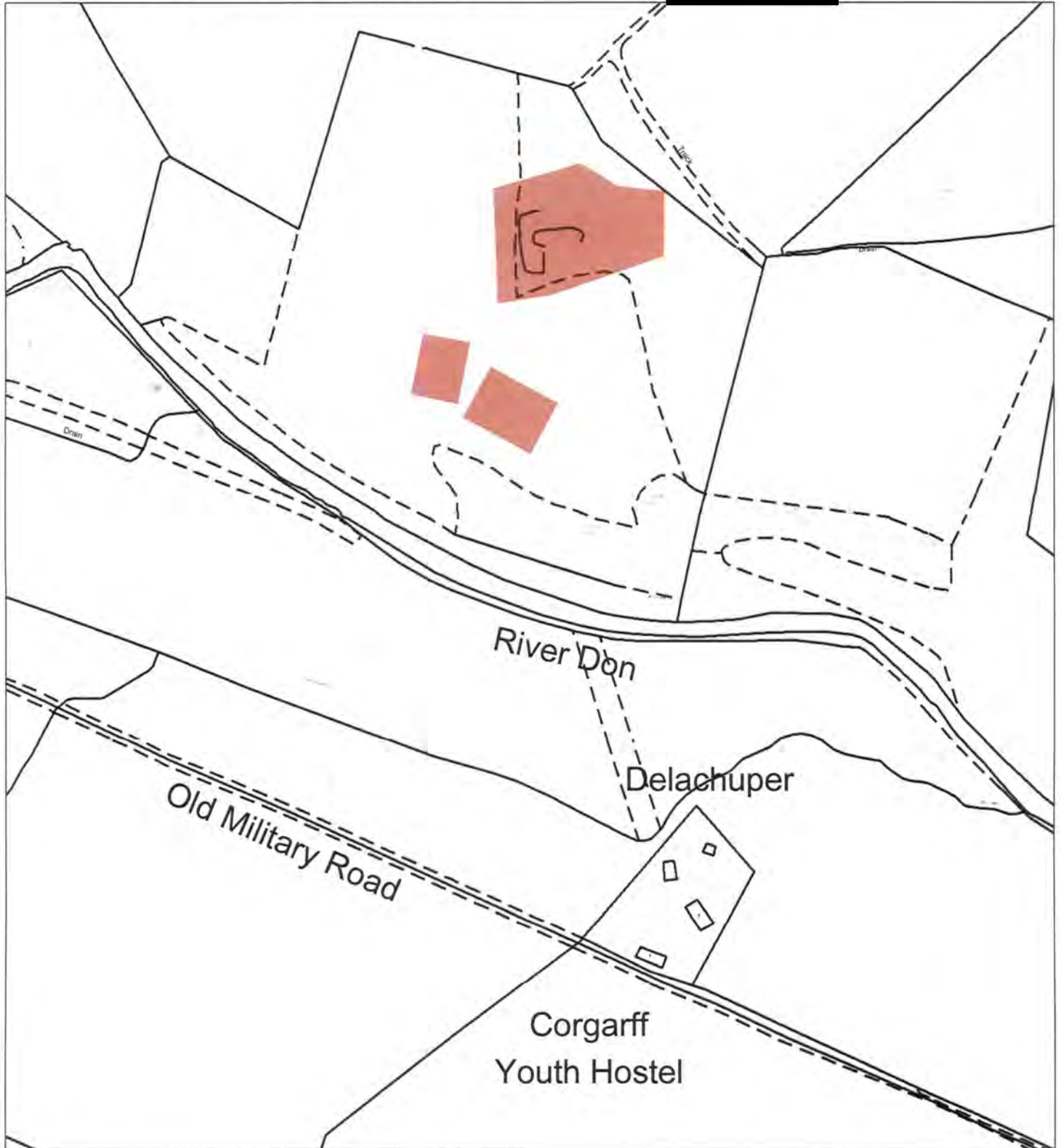
