The monument known as The Barmkyn, fort and cairn, comprises a bivallate hillfort and cairn of prehistoric date, visible as upstanding remains. The area to be scheduled is circular and comprises the remains described and an area around them within which related material may be expected to be found. The top 0.50m of the forestry track is excluded from the scheduling. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Keig and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

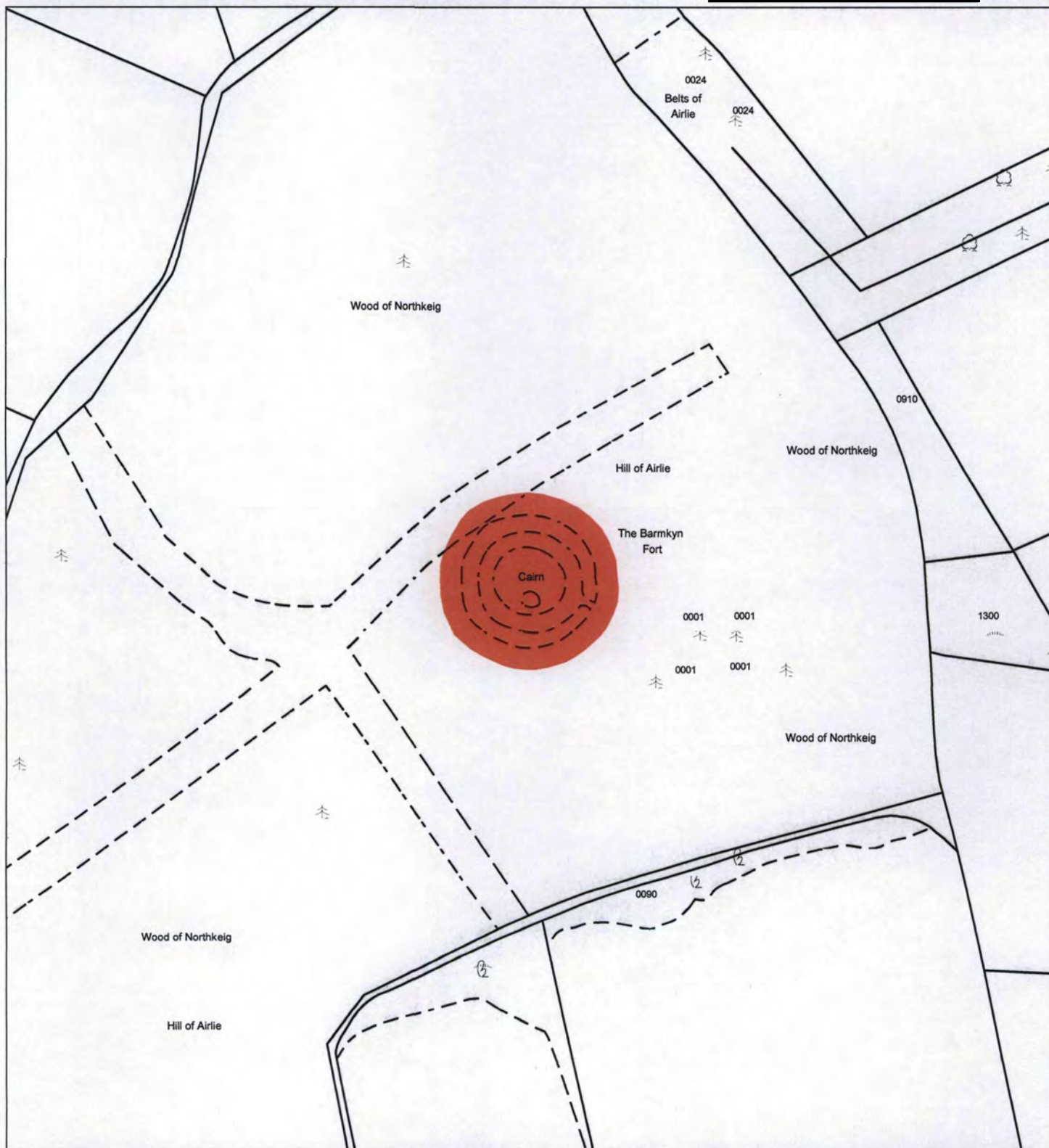

Scheduled Area 

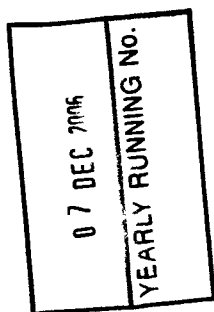
