



THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

11575

The monument known as Bell Knowe, cairn, Rhynie, comprises a mound of rounded boulders and pebbles set in a matrix of sandy soil. It lies on the crest of an E-facing slope in pasture, overlooking the valley of the Water of Bogie. The area to be scheduled is irregular, to include the cairn and an area around it in which evidence for its construction and use may survive. The scheduled area excludes the fence on its W and S edges, to allow for their maintenance. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Rhynie and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

 hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

Subscribed by Malcolm Cooper, Chief Inspector with Historic Scotland, being an officer of the Scottish Ministers at Edinburgh on the 1 day of *May* Two thousand and seven, before this witness Victoria Ball, of Longmore House, Salisbury Place, Edinburgh.

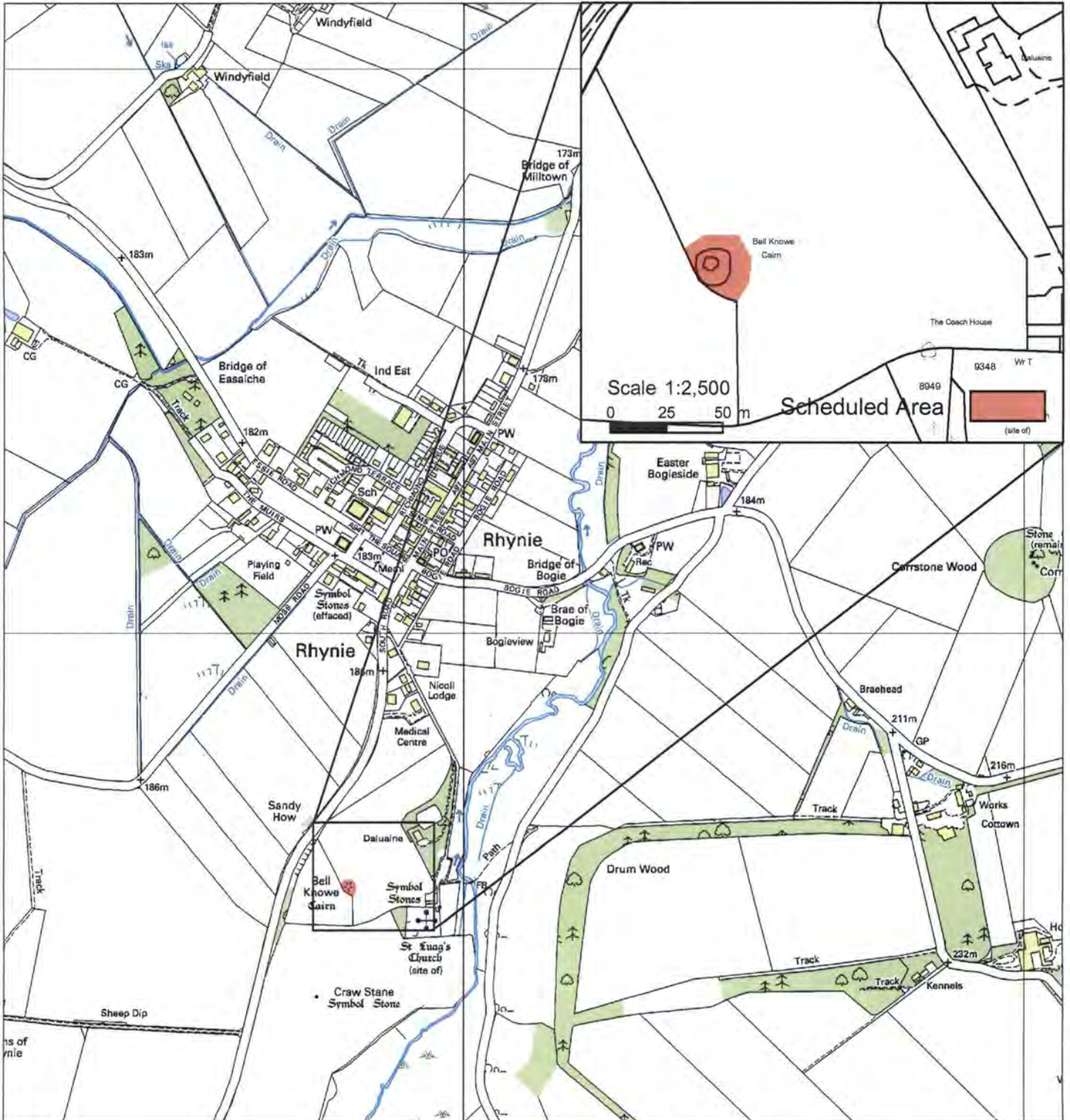
