

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Knock Hill, hut circle, 315m NNE of Fernyhowe, comprises a hut circle, the footings of a prehistoric house between 2000 and 3000 years old. It is situated in rough pasture on a broad ridge on the S side of Knock Hill, within a group of prehistoric burial cairns, hut circles and relic field systems identified on Knock Hill. The hut circle survives as an approximately circular, turf-covered stony bank measuring 16m in diameter overall and up to 0.6m high. The interior is 6m across, enclosed by the bank (wall footing) spread up to 4m wide. The bank is pierced by an entrance on the E side. The interior is uneven, with two distinct hollows. The area to be scheduled is circular, centred on the hut circle, to include the visible remains and an area around in which evidence relating to its construction and use may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Logie-Coldstone and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

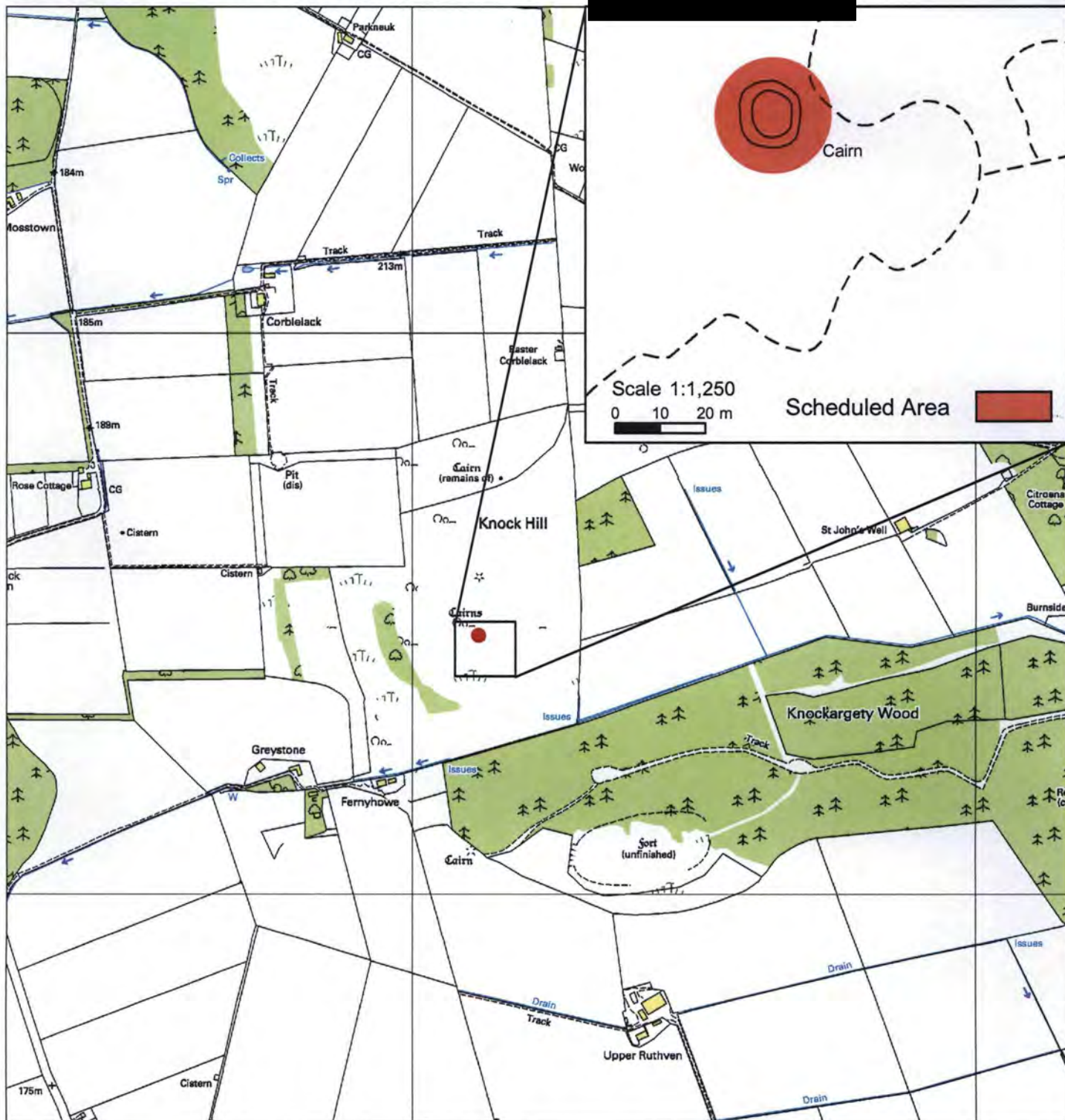

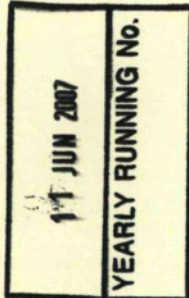
