

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Auldtown, burnt mound 640m SW of, comprises a burnt mound, a prehistoric site generally thought to be associated with food preparation. It lies at a height of 375m OD, immediately to the S of the source of a small burn that springs from the E face of the ridge that forms the N flank of Baderonach Hill. The burnt mound survives as a heather- and turf-covered mound, roughly oval, with a central hollow. The mound measures 9.2m from E-W by 8m transversely and up to 1.2m in height. The area to be scheduled is circular, to include the visible remains and an area around in which evidence relating to the construction and use of the site may be expected to survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Towie and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

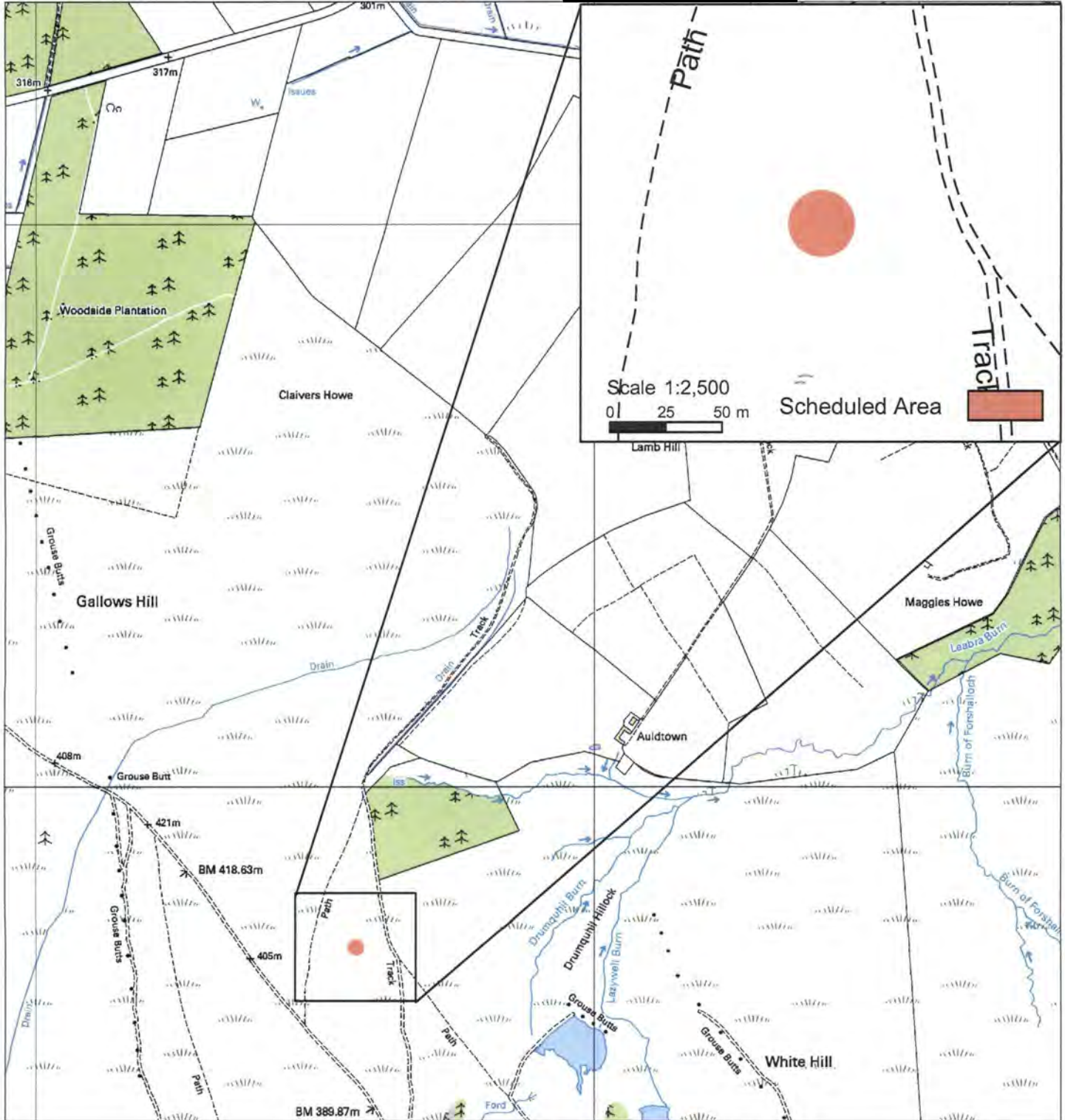

Scheduled Area

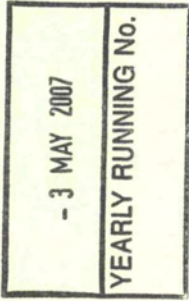
