

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979

The monument known as Lang Stane o' Craigearn, standing stone 50m N of Littlewood Cottage comprises a single, large monolith of likely late Neolithic or early Bronze-Age date. The stone occupies a position 90m above sea level and sits on the crest of a small hill in a paddock within the grounds of Littlewood Cottage. The earthfast granite stone measures 1.15m in breadth NE/SW by 0.65m in thickness, and stands to a height of 3.5m. The area to be scheduled is a circle centred on the stone, to include the stone and a surrounding area where there is potential for further archaeological remains related to the stone's use and erection to survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kemnay and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

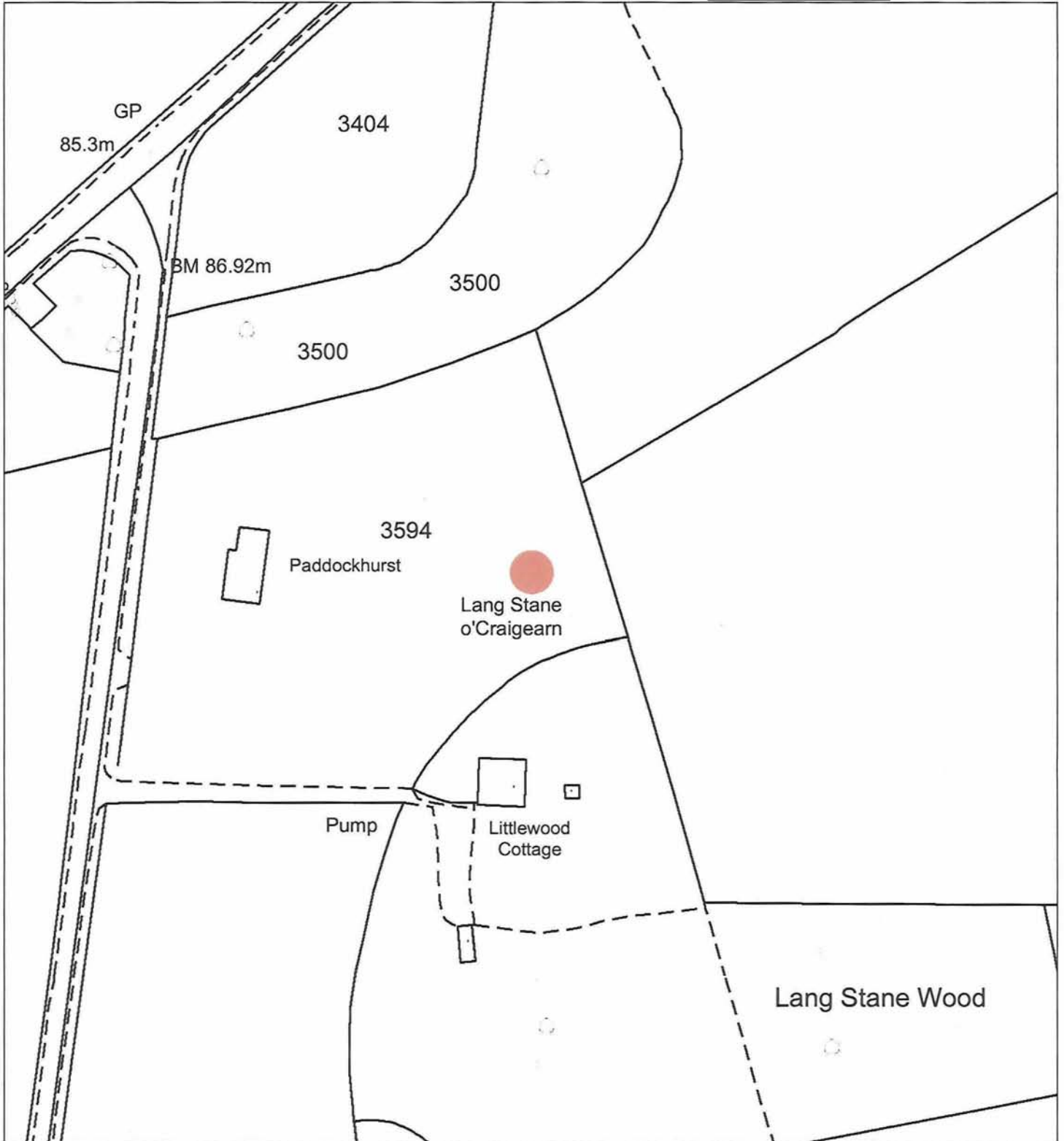
