



THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979

The monument known as Hill of Bandodle, farmstead 210m SSE of comprises the remains of a pre-Improvement, potentially earlier, farmstead surviving as a well-preserved set of earthworks, specifically two round-ended buildings, a turf bank, four clearance cairns and an associated field system. The site is located 100m NE of the summit of Bandodle, in the south of Strathdon, at an altitude of 255m above sea level. The area to be scheduled is irregular on plan to include the remains described and an area around within which evidence relating to their construction and use may survive. The scheduling specifically excludes the above-ground elements of all fence lines within the scheduled area, to allow for their maintenance. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Midmar and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

 is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.
