



THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 12188
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Whiteinches, cairn 440m SSW of comprises the remains of a Bronze-Age burial cairn. The cairn is now grass-grown and is sited on the SE flank of a low rise named Backley Hill, in an area of cultivated land at 125m above sea level. The monument measures 14m in diameter and 1.5m in height. The area to be scheduled is circular, centred on the centre of the cairn to include the remains described and an area around within which evidence relating to its construction and use may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Chapel of Garioch and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

 is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

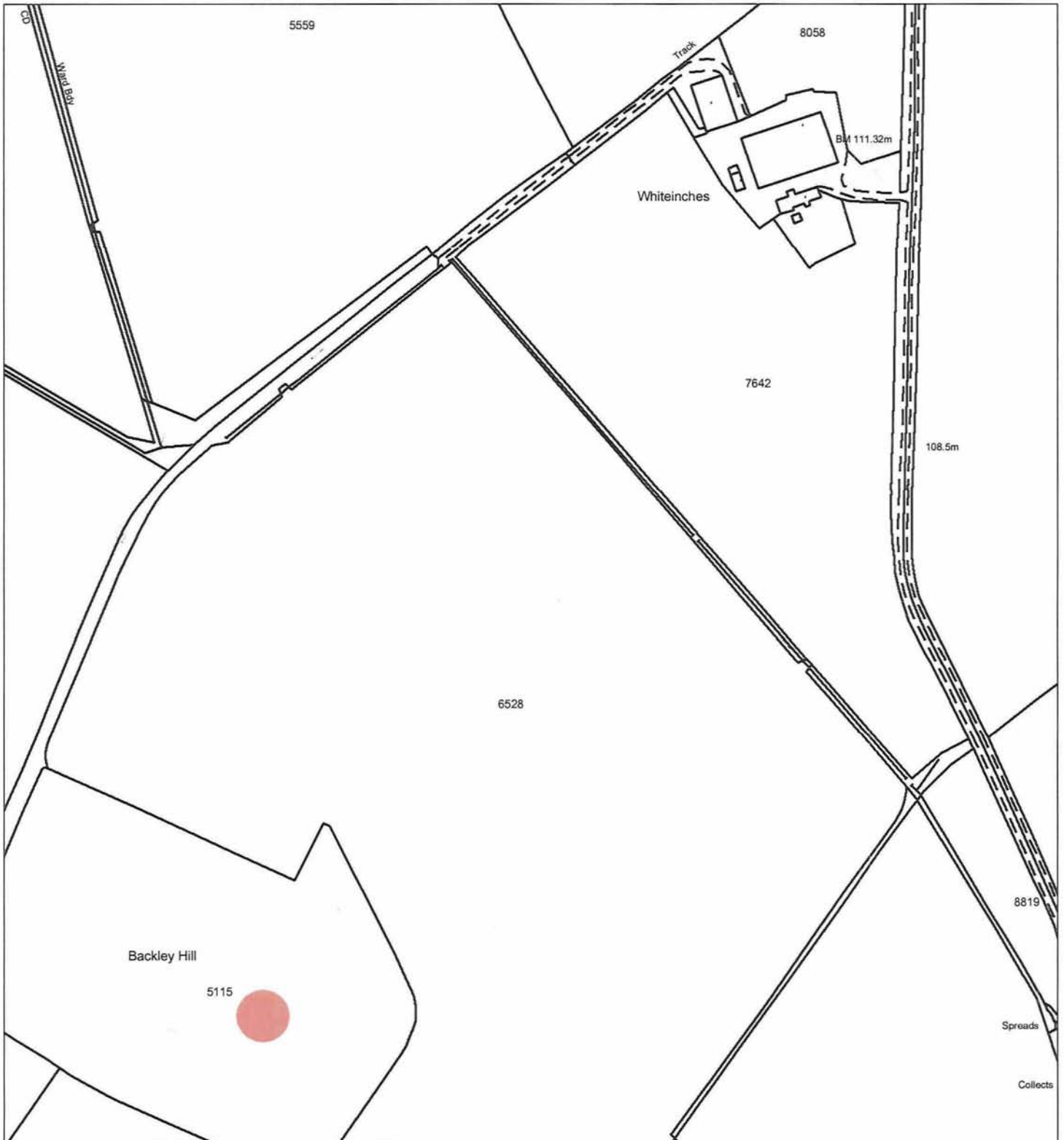
