

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 12328  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Cairntradlin Cottage, standing stone 480m W of comprises a single standing stone likely to date to the late Neolithic or Bronze Age. It survives as an upstanding monolith within a cultivated field, 100m above sea level. The standing stone is located on N-facing, gently sloping ground less than 2km south of the River Don and WNW of the locally high ground surrounding Tyrebagger Hill. The earthfast granite boulder measures 0.6m at its widest and 1.5m high. It is broadly square in plan, tapering slightly towards its top and it leans very slightly to the south-east. The area to be scheduled is circular on plan centred on the stone, to include the remains described and an area around within which evidence relating to their construction and use may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kinellar and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

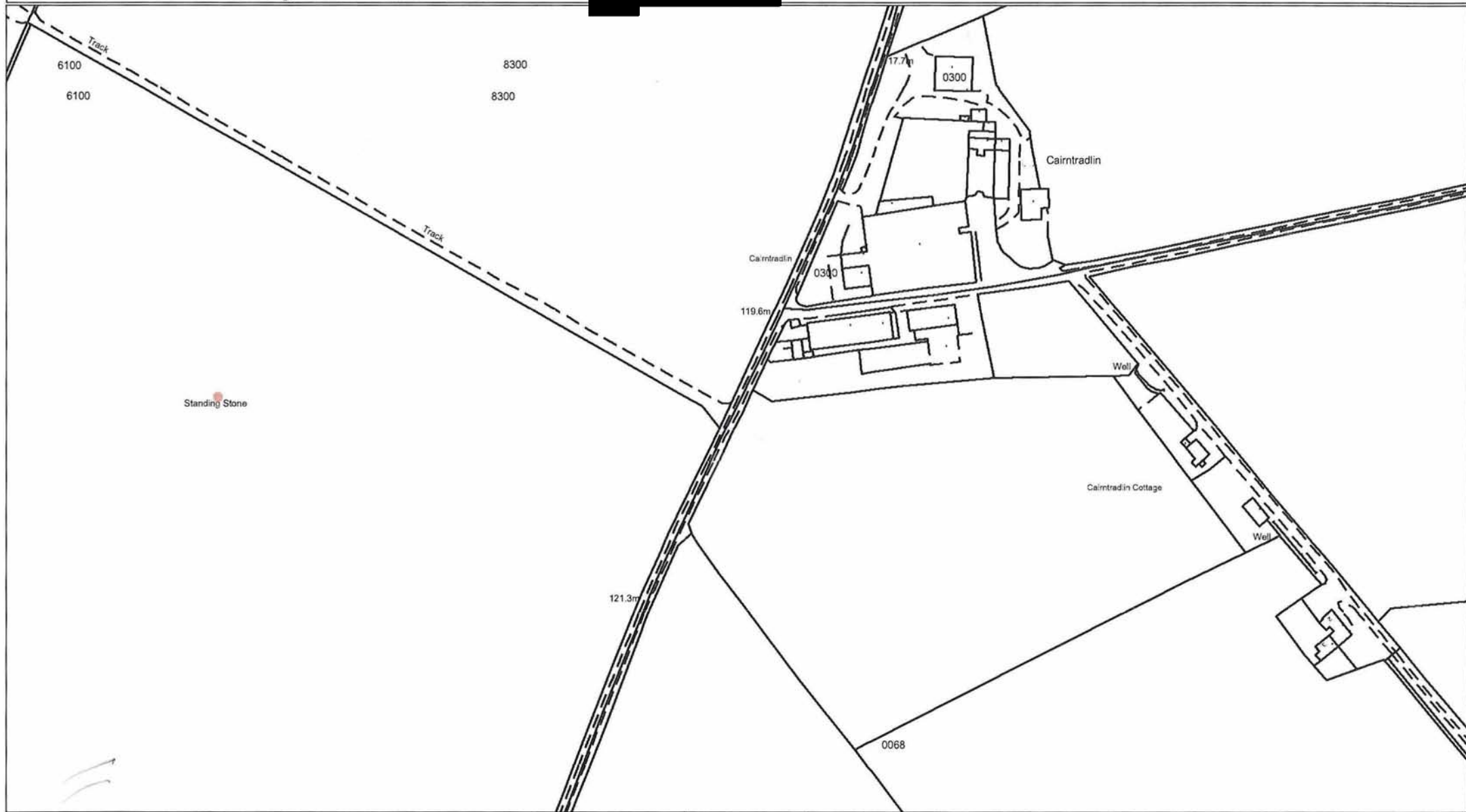

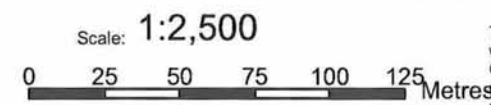
