

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 12346
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Donald's Hillock, cairn comprises a burial monument of probable Bronze-Age date. It survives as a substantial, circular earthen mound that is largely surrounded by a modern drystone retaining wall. The monument is located on the N flood plain of the River Don at 55m above sea level. The monument measures 17m in diameter and rises to 2m high. A First World War memorial has been built on the top of the mound, it is accessed from the NW by an access gate, steps and a gravel path that is slightly cut into the mound. The area to be scheduled is circular on plan, to include the remains described and an area around within which evidence relating to their construction and use may survive. Specifically excluded from this scheduling to allow for their maintenance are the above-ground elements of the war memorial, the retaining wall where it stands proud of the mound, the iron access gate and the utility supply marker. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Fintray and the County of Aberdeen as shown in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

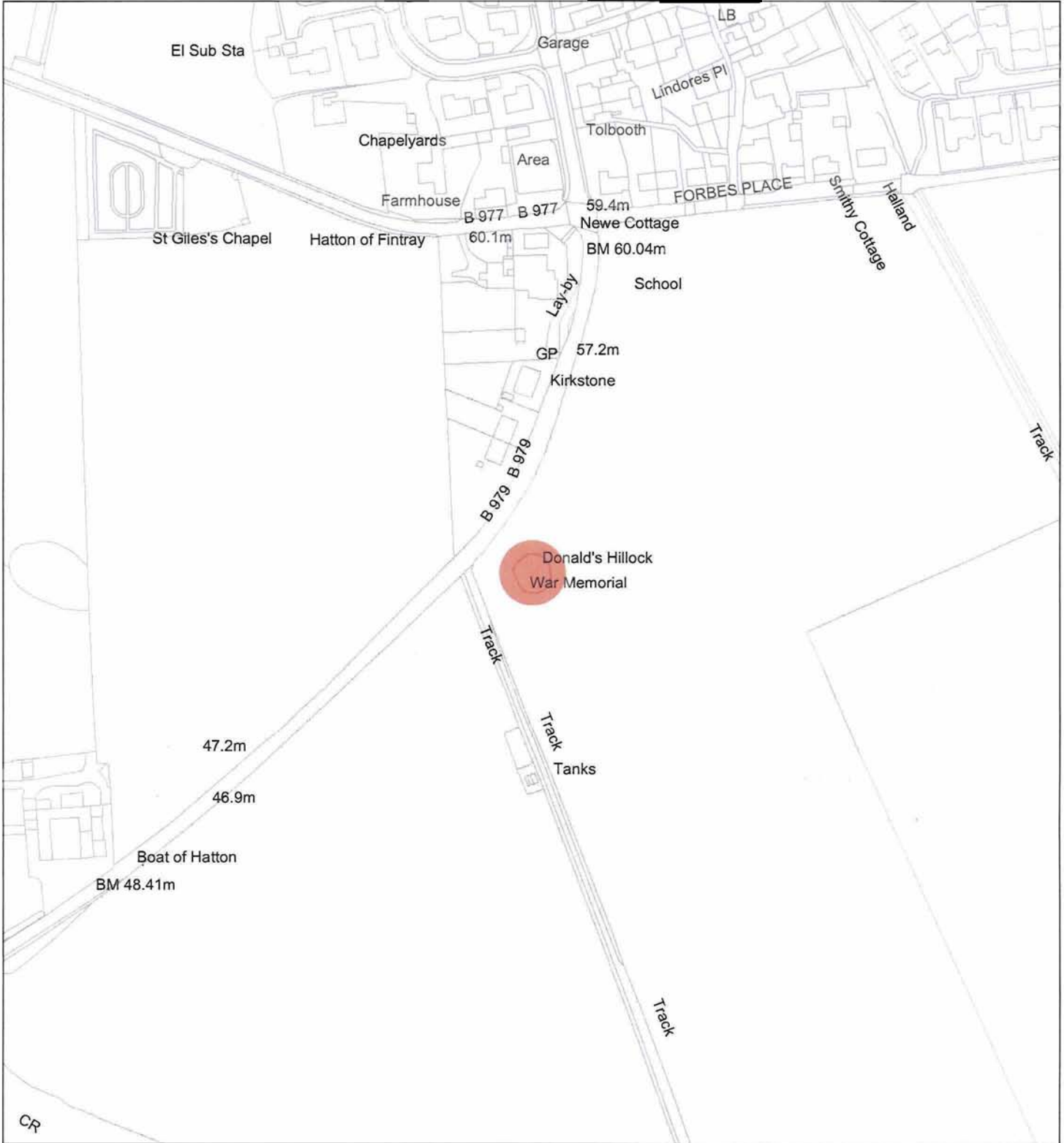
