

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 12352
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Larrick, cairn 435m NW of comprises a burial cairn of probable neolithic or Bronze-Age date. It survives as a large, grass-covered earth-and-stone mound with a superimposed penannular-shaped feature on its southern half. The cairn is located above the northern river terrace overlooking the River Don, west-north-west of Hatton of Fintray. It sits in a woodland clearing surrounded by mature conifers at 80m above sea level. The cairn measures 12m in diameter and is 1m high. It is circular on plan with a roughly crescent-shaped feature and depression at its southern end. The area to be scheduled is circular on plan, centred on the cairn, to include the remains described and an area around within which evidence relating to their construction and use may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Fintray and the County of Aberdeen as shown in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

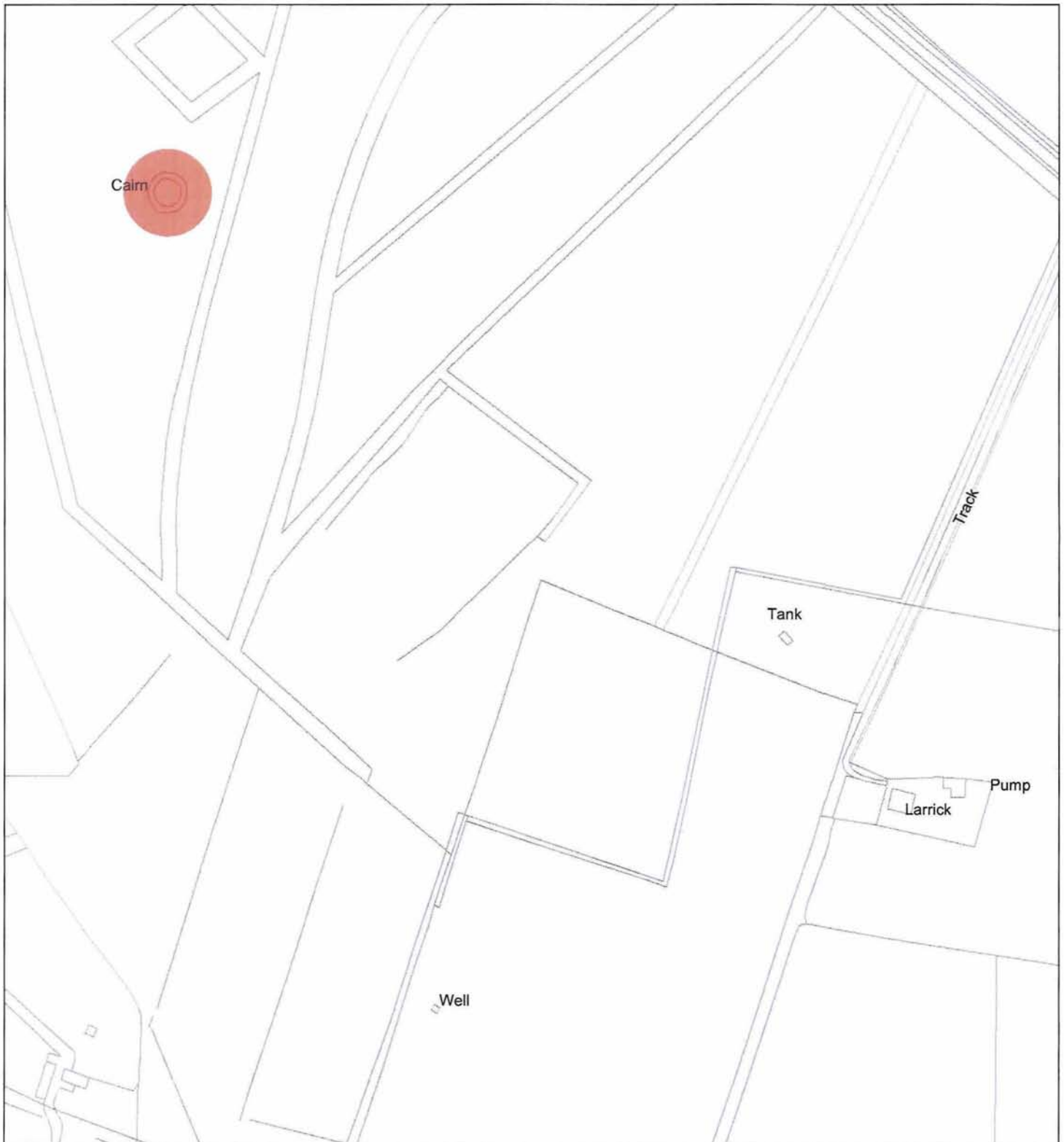
