

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 12418
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Middlehill, cairn 105m N of comprises a burial cairn likely to date to the neolithic or Bronze Age. It survives as a tree- and turf-covered mound, located at 105m above sea level on a low S-facing knoll, overlooking the River Don 2km to the south. The cairn measures 6m in diameter and around its perimeter a number of large stones are visible. It survives to 0.7m in height and sits on a low knoll. The area to be scheduled is circular on plan, centred on the mound, to include the remains described and an area around within which evidence relating to its construction and use may survive. The scheduling extends as far as, but does not include, the post-and-wire fence running to the south of the cairn. The monument, which lies in the Parish of New Machar and the County of Aberdeen as shown in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

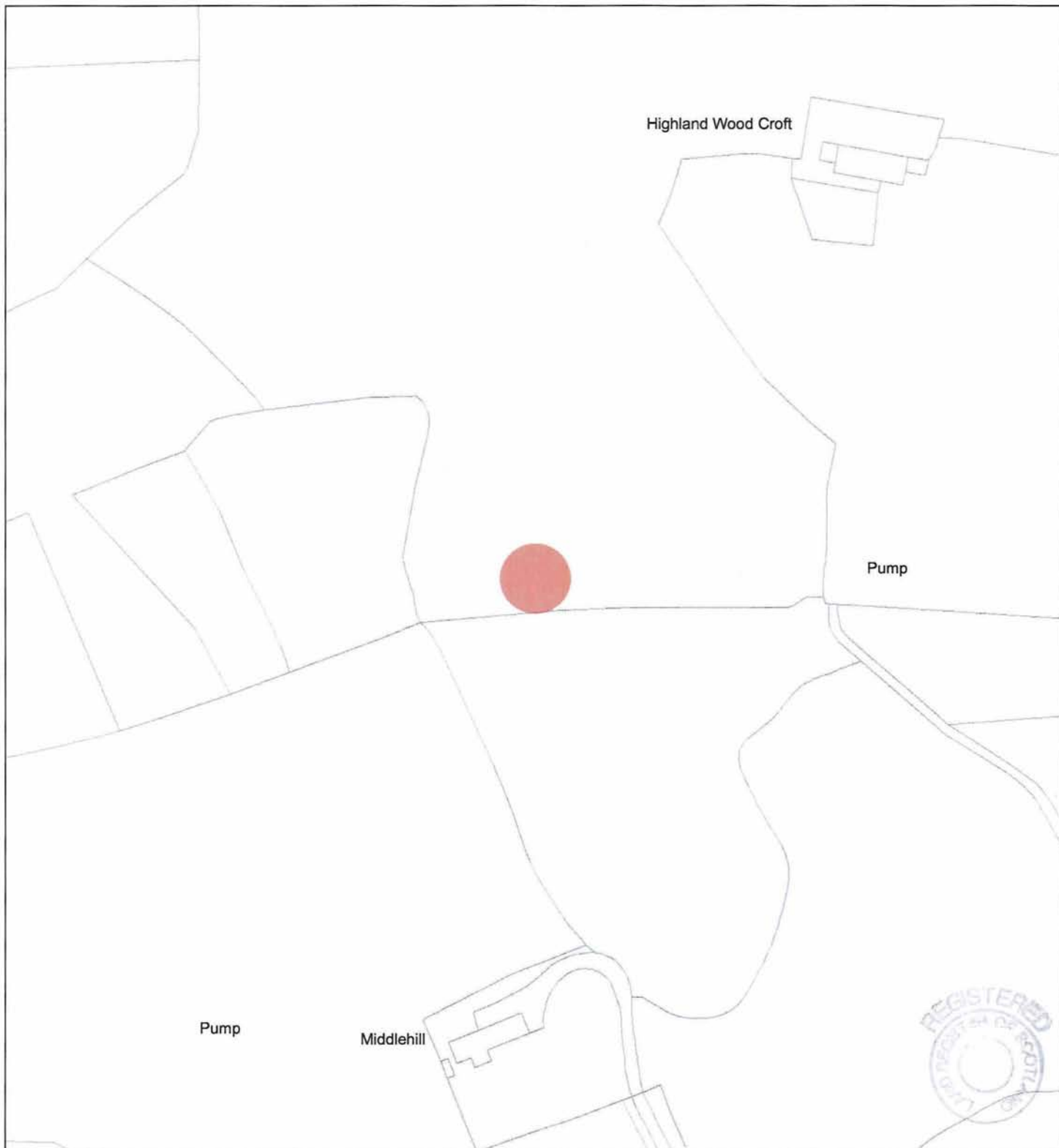


