

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 12426  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as 4 Shethin Cottages, cairn 310m WNW of comprises the remains of a cairn of probable neolithic or Bronze-Age date. It survives as a ring of approximately twelve stones. The monument which measures 5m in diameter is located on the summit of Fountain Hill at 85m above sea level. The tallest upstanding stone measures 1.6m in height, while most of the stones measure less than 0.4m in height. The area to be scheduled is circular on plan, centred on the monument, to include the remains described and an area around them within which evidence relating to their construction and use may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Tarves and the County of Aberdeen as shown in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]
