

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 12438  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as The Hedges, enclosure 480m S of comprises the remains of a later prehistoric enclosed settlement visible in cropmarks on aerial photographs. The monument lies in low-lying arable land at 55m above sea level, on a rise on the N flank of Strathdon. The monument is broadly circular in shape and measures 27m in diameter. The area to be scheduled is irregular on plan, centred on the cropmark, to include the remains described and an area around them within which related material may be expected to be found. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Fintray and the County of Aberdeen as shown in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

Scheduled Area



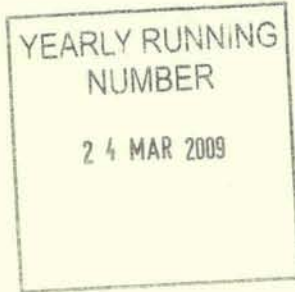
